Prevention of Cancer

Although many forms of cancer are not preventable, cancer risk can be lowered in a number of ways, including:

- ✓ Consuming a nutritious diet high in fruits & vegetables
- ✓ Regular exercise and maintaining a healthy weight
- ✓ Abstaining from tobacco products
- ✓ Minimum alcohol consumption
- ☑ Protection from ultraviolet rays (sunscreen, protective clothing)
- ☑ Regular cancer screenings
- Avoiding harmful chemicals in the environment
- ✓ Vaccination against Human Papillomavirus (HPV)

As members of **The Bharat Scouts and Guides**, we have a duty to contribute to the well-being of our community. Therefore, all State Associations are requested to organize **awareness programs**, **health camps**, **and outreach activities** aimed at educating the public about cancer prevention.

Please ensure these programs reach as many people as possible, especially in areas where cancer awareness is limited. Let us collectively work towards spreading knowledge and saving lives.

- Cancer Awareness Seminar Expert talks on cancer prevention, early detection, and treatment strategies.
- 2 % Health Check-up Camp Free cancer screening services for early detection.

- ✓ Pledge Drive Students, employees, and community members pledge to quit tobacco, alcohol, and adopt a healthy lifestyle.
- Social Media Campaign Share informative posts using hashtag #NationalCancerAwarenessDay2025, #BSGAgainstCancer #BSGINDIA.
- Awareness Walk/Run Organize a walkathon, rally, or cycle rally with placards & slogans.
- **Poster/Slogan Competition** Encourage students and youth to create posters or slogans on cancer awareness.
- 1 Healthy Living Drive Plant trees or start "No Junk Food Day" in schools/units to promote wellness.
- Survivor Interaction Session Invite cancer survivors to share their experiences and motivate participants.
