Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters.

We are glad to inform you that The Hong Kong Girl Guides Association (HKGGA) is organising its 110th Anniversary International Camp – "Lead Her Pixoverse" from 23rd to 27th December 2026 at Runway 1331, Hong Kong. The camp celebrates 110 years of Girl Guiding in Hong Kong and aims to bring together Girl Guides and Girl Scouts from around the world for five days of leadership, friendship, adventure, cultural exchange and international cooperation.

The theme of the camp, "Lead Her Pixoverse", is inspired by the concept of a limitless metaverse, encouraging participants to explore innovation, technology, leadership and personal growth through interactive learning experiences. The programme is built around the core values of Technology, Breakthrough and Leadership, while incorporating the six WAGGGS Leadership Mindsets.

Package 2 additionally includes a post-camp local tour and one-night accommodation at an HKGGA Centre or Host Family (subject to availability).

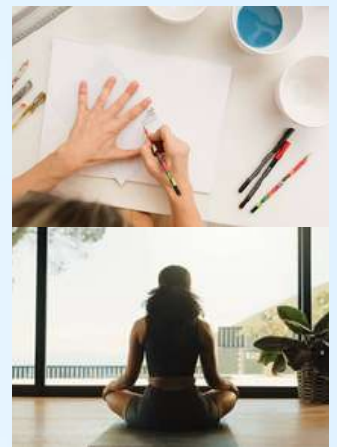

 - Bank transfer record.
- 4 A confirmation email will be sent upon payment confirmation.

CAMP FEE FOR INTERNATIONAL PARTICIPANTS:

PACKAGE 1: CAMP ONLY

PACKAGE 2: CAMP + TOUR

~~US\$640~~ → **US\$580**

Note: Fees have been adjusted due to HKGGA's secured funding for overseas participants.

Both packages are inclusive of:

- Basic room amenities
- All programme, souvenirs, food & accommodation at the Camp
- All transportation costs to and from the campsite

Not inclusive of:

- Airfare to and from Hong Kong
- Travel insurance
- Personal gears

Additional programmes in Package 2:

- A 2-day-1-night stay at a HKGGA centre; **or** stay with a host family
- A 1-day post-camp local tour around Hong Kong, exploring history & ecology within **Frontier Closed Areas (special approval by the local government)**. More details will be shared later.

Remarks:

Package 2 is exclusive to international participants. The arrangement of host family is subject to availability.

VISA & TRAVEL

VISA

Check if you need a visa or travel authorisation to enter Hong Kong. Requirements vary by country. You can find out more about the Visa requirements for your country at the Hong Kong Immigrations Department website [here](#).

If you need any documents to enter Hong Kong, we suggest you start your application process as soon as possible.

TRAVEL

Temperature & Climate:

December is widely considered one of the best times to visit Hong Kong. Expect comfortable temperatures between 15°C and 20°C with low humidity, and up to 25°C during warmer days.

Clothing:

We suggest packing “onion-styled” layered clothing, including light sweaters and a windbreaker to handle chilly air-conditioned interiors and occasional evening sea breezes.

Footwear & Gear:

Hong Kong is a walking city. Bring comfortable sneakers or shoes.

LIVING AT RUNWAY 1331: WHAT TO EXPECT

Imagine sleeping on an airport runway...

Located at the tip of the historic Kai Tak Runway, Runway 1331 is a unique revitalisation project in Hong Kong that has transformed the retired Kai Tak International Airport into a vibrant, youth-focused community hub, offering a blend of modern living and creative energy.

Runway 1331 is now a "Youth Incubator", which includes **common areas** for **artistic exchange**, **co-working spaces**, and **outdoor activity zones**. Guests can enjoy a quiet, spacious environment compared to the typical density of downtown Hong Kong, with the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal Park and Victoria Harbour just a short stroll away.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When is the application deadline?

Please submit both the **Contingent Registration Form** and **bank transfer record** by **31 July 2026 (deadline extended)**. Registration cannot be confirmed until payment is received.

How do I complete the payment?

You may transfer the Camp Fee to HKGGA's bank account as stated in the Contingent Registration Form. Please note that:

- Payment should be made in Hong Kong Dollars;
- Please include your MO name in the transfer record;
- More details are available in the Contingent Registration Form.

Can dietary restrictions be accommodated?

Yes. Please specify any dietary requirements for your MO in the Contingent Registration Form.

Why are birth dates and email addresses required during registration?

This data is essential for the 110A Camp activities. Please rest assured that all information is stored securely and used exclusively for camp-related purposes.

How do I register for Post-Camp Tours?

These tours are exclusive to MOs opting for Camp Package 2. Indicate your package choice on the Contingent Registration Form, and the 110A Camp team will contact eligible MOs with further details.

Are male leaders and participants allowed?

Male unit leaders are welcome but will be assigned shared rooms with other male leaders (potentially different MOs). Meanwhile, all participants must be Girl Guides/ Girl Scouts.
