An amount of **₹2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only)** per participant is to be deposited in advance towards the Scout Guide Welfare Fund as a registration fee. The

registration fee is **non-refundable** under any circumstances, including non-participation after selection.

Confirmation of booking will be communicated only upon receipt of the registration fee.

The Application Form, along with the Medical Certificate and Risk Undertaking Certificate in original, must be produced at the time of registration. Participants will not be permitted to attend the programme without submission of these mandatory documents.

The participation fee shall cover all programme-related expenses, including meals (from breakfast on the first day to lunch on the last day), accommodation, inland transportation from Raiwala to Kedarnath & Badrinath and return, as well as event souvenirs.

Accommodation will be arranged in tents at Raiwala and hotel accommodation in other locations, depending on availability and location.

Each participant will be awarded a National Level Participation Certificate upon successful completion of the programme.

Booking & Selection:

Booking of seats will be made on a "**First Come, First Served**" basis. A Selection Letter will be issued upon receipt of the registration fee of ₹2,000/- per participant under the Scout Guide Welfare Fund, along with details of participants (male & female).

The balance participation fee per head must be remitted through online transfer within 15 days prior to the commencement of the programme, upon receipt of the Selection Letter.

One Escort must be deputed with a group of 1 to 10 Boys / Girls. Lady escort must be deputed with the female participants. Escorts should also register and pay the full fee along with Application, Medical Certificate. No one is permitted to stay in the camp

without Registration and Medical Certificate. No age limit for escort teacher but he/she should be physically & medically fit. Preference may please be given to under 50 years of age who is physically and medically fit.

NOTE: Without confirmation letter, participants will not be admitted in the camp.

Eligibility (Who Can Participate):

The programme is open to members of the Bharat Scouts and Guides, educational institutions, adventure clubs, well-wishers of the organization, and other youth organizations interested in adventure activities.



Participants should be in the age group of 16 to 50 years, and must be physically and medically fit to undertake trekking and related activities. Individuals may also participate independently with valid identity proof.

All participants are required to register on the Government of Uttarakhand portal at: <https://registrationandtouristcare.uk.gov.in> as per the prescribed norms.

HOW TO REACH : Base Campsite, STC, Raiwala, Uttarakhand

➤ Nearest Railway Station is Haridwar /Raiwala. Share auto rickshaw is available from Haridwar to Raiwala campsite. From Raiwala Railway Station, campsite is walkable distance. One can also Board a bus plying to Rishikesh get down at Raiwala Bus stand.

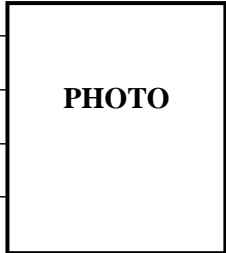

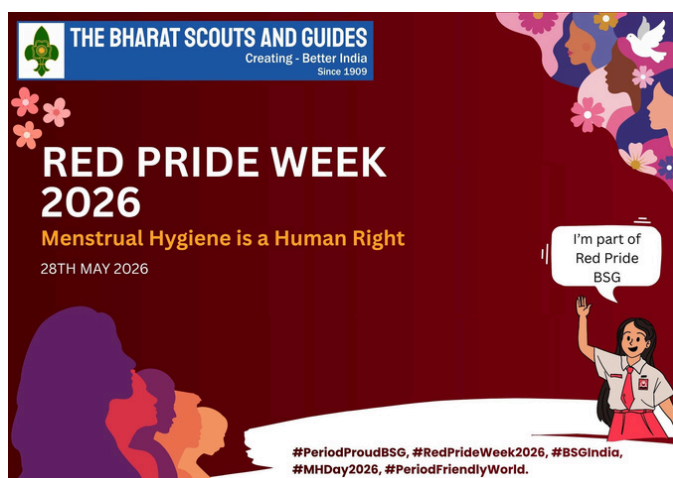

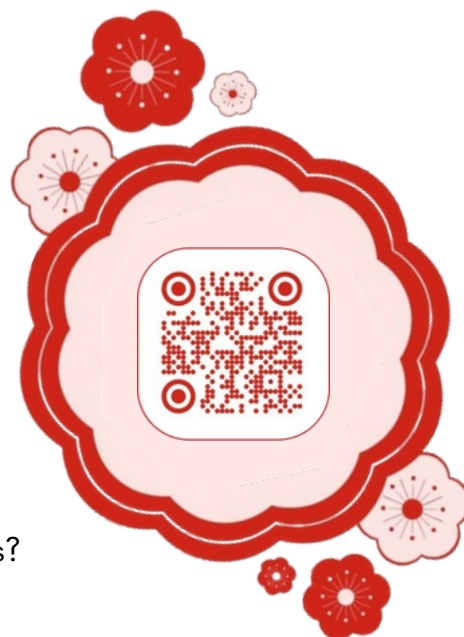

Booking will be made on "**First Come First Serve Basis**". Selection Letter will be sent on receipt of Scout Guide Welfare Fund as registration fee ₹ 1000/- per head. The balance amount of **₹4500/- per head** must be remitted via online bank transfer at least fifteen days before the Camp.

Rs.5500/- Per head to be remitted toward **Scout Guide Welfare Fund (This will cover Accommodation, Food, Souvenir Items and Activities) including educational tour (Sightseeing) to North + South Goa by Bus & Cruise ride in Mandovi river.**

The original Application, Medical & Risk Institutional certificate should be produced at the time of Registration, without these mandatory documents participants will not be admitted. **Each Participant will be awarded National Level Participation Certificate on successful completion of the programme.**

Note: No one is permitted to stay in the camp without Registration and Medical Certificate. No age limit for escort teacher but he/she should be physically & medically fit. Preference may be given to under 50 years of age.

Eligibility (Who can participate) : The programme is open to members of The Bharat Scouts and Guides, educational institutions, adventure clubs, well-wishers of the organizations, and other youth organizations interested in adventure activities.



Participants should be in the age group of 12 to 45 years and must be Physically and medically fit and can bear the strain of adventure and related activities. Individuals may also participate independently with valid Government identity proof.

Programmes: Adventure Activities – Visit to North Goa - Baga Beach, Calangute Beach, Anjuna Beach, Sinquerim Beach, Vagatur Beach. South Goa - Colva Beach, Basilica of Bom Jesus and Se Cathedral church in Old Goa, Mangeshi Temple, Tirupathi Balaji Temple.

Cruise ride in Mandovi river, Trek Visit to Panjim Market, Backwoods Cooking, Knowledge of Scouting & Guiding Activities, Camp Fire, Adventure-Based Activities, Nature Exploration of Goa.

- ❖ Personal Medicines if any.



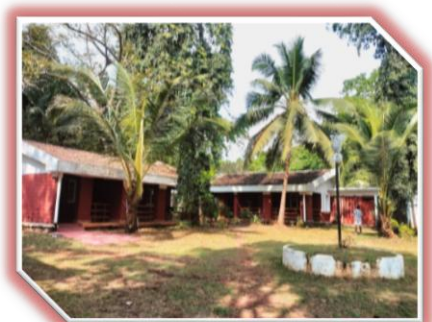

How to reach – Bamboo Motels & Hotels Campsite, Goa.

- Participants may get down at Karmali Railway Station. Buses are available from the railway station to Bamboo Motels & Hotels, which is approximately 17 km away.
- Participants arriving at Madgaon Railway Station or Madgaon Bus Stand can reach the Base Camp by road. The distance from Madgaon to the Base Camp is approximately 40 km. Local buses, taxis, and other transport facilities are readily available for convenient travel to the campsite
