Voluntary Financial Support:

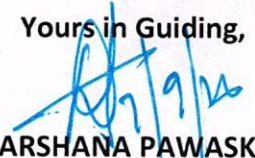

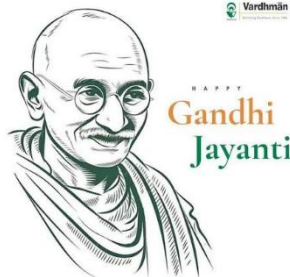

Organize or participate in an **All-Faith Prayer Meeting** at Unit, District, State or other appropriate level to promote communal harmony, peace and mutual respect.

5. Save the Earth – Plant & Nurture

Plant saplings at home, school or in the locality and take responsibility for their regular care and growth.

6. Essay, Debate, Drawing & Painting Competitions

Organize competitions on themes such as:

- **Non-Violence and Peace**
- **Gandhiji's Values in Modern Life**
- **Clean India and Sustainable Living**

7. Dress Up Like Gandhi

Dress up and enact the role of Mahatma Gandhi. Participants may record a short video or take a photograph and share it on social media.

8. Khadi & Charkha – Atmanirbhar Bharat

Wear **Khadi attire** on Gandhi Jayanti and organize a **Charkha demonstration/exhibition** to promote self-reliance, sustainable livelihoods and Gandhiji's values.

9. Service to Society

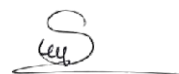
Undertake a service activity for the benefit of the community, such as assisting senior citizens, supporting needy persons, distributing essential items or conducting awareness activities on peace, cleanliness and social responsibility.

THEME 2026: “End child marriage and invest in girls’ rights”

The 2026 theme calls for urgent action to prevent child marriage and strengthen investment in girls’ **rights, education, safety, opportunities and leadership**.

The Bharat Scouts and Guides, through its educational and youth development programmes, has a significant role in developing **confidence, leadership, life skills, resilience and responsible citizenship** among girls.

Therefore, all State Associations are encouraged to observe the International Day of the Girl Child in a **girl-led, action-oriented and community-focused manner**.

Convergence with Government Initiatives

The activities may suitably complement the objectives of **Beti Bachao Beti Padhao** under the Ministry of Women and Child Development, particularly in promoting the value, education and empowerment of the girl child.

The objectives of **Mission Shakti** and relevant child protection and support initiatives under **Mission Vatsalya** may also be appropriately highlighted during awareness and community outreach activities.

State Associations may coordinate with the concerned Government Departments, educational institutions, local authorities and other stakeholders, wherever appropriate, for effective implementation of the programme.

Suggested Activities for Observance of International Day of The Girl Child

- **1. Girls Speak – Girls Lead**
Provide a platform for Guides and Rangers to express their aspirations, concerns, ideas and views.
-  **2. Awareness on Girls' Rights**
Conduct awareness programmes on girls' rights, education, equality, safety and leadership.
-  **3. Say NO to Child Marriage**
Organise awareness campaigns, discussions and community outreach programmes on the prevention of child marriage.
-  **4. Girls in Leadership**
Organise leadership activities, group discussions, Scout-Guide projects and decision-making exercises led by Guides and Rangers.
-  **5. Career Guidance & Women Leadership Interaction**
Arrange interaction with successful women professionals, administrators, entrepreneurs, educators and community leaders.
-  **6. Personal Safety & Well-being**
Conduct age-appropriate sessions on personal safety, health, hygiene, well-being and building confidence.
-  **7. Creative Competitions**
Organise **Essay Writing, Poster Making, Storytelling, Quiz and Slogan Writing** competitions based on the theme.
-  **8. “My Dream, My Future”**
Encourage girls to share their dreams, aspirations, career goals and vision for their future.
-  **9. Parent & Community Interaction**
Involve parents, teachers, community leaders and local stakeholders to strengthen support for girls' education, safety and development.
-  **10. Girl Child Pledge**
Organise a collective pledge to **respect girls' rights, prevent child marriage, support education and create a safe and equal environment for every girl.**
-  **11. Community Service by Girls**
Encourage Guides and Rangers to undertake a girl-led community service project addressing a local need.
-  **12. Creative Expression**
Organise **Poster Making, Essay Writing, Slogan Writing, Storytelling, Quiz and Drawing Competitions** based on the theme.

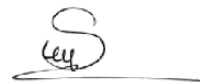

4. Cultural Diversity Programme

Organise cultural programmes presenting the **languages, traditional dress, folk dances, music, food, art and traditions** of different regions of India.

5. India’s Unity in Diversity Exhibition

Create exhibitions showcasing India's **heritage, languages, folk art, traditions, monuments, festivals and cultural diversity**.

6. Essay, Quiz, Debate & Storytelling

Organise competitions on **Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, national integration, unity in diversity and the importance of responsible citizenship**.

7. Patriotic Songs & Cultural Presentation
