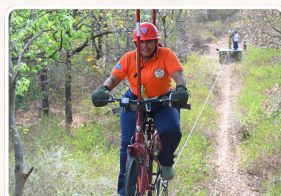

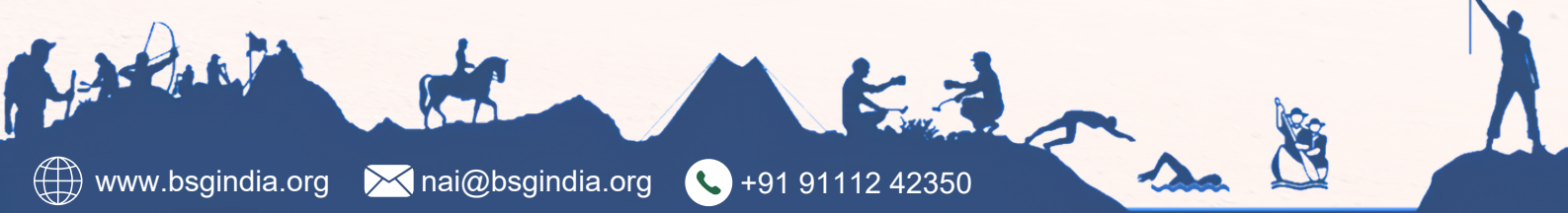

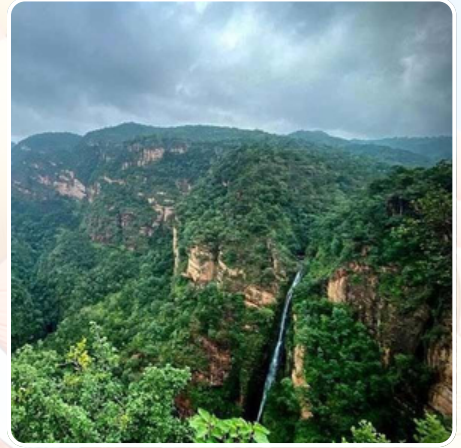

### ELIGIBILITY

- The programme is open to members of The Bharat Scouts and Guides, institutions, adventure clubs, well-wishers of the organizations, and other youth organizations interested in adventure activities.
- Age group of **12 to 55 years** and must be Physically and medically fit.
- Participants should have successfully completed a National Adventure Programme earlier.

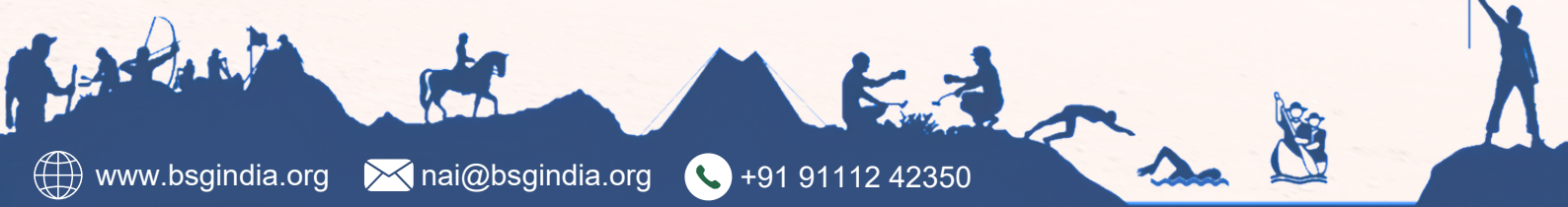
 **Uniform:** One complete and correct Uniform as per APRO Part II & III **(Mandatory for BSG Members only)**.

## ACCOMMODATION



Comfortable tent accommodation will be provided for all participants and escorting teachers within the campus of the Institute. The campsite will offer a safe, secure, and well-managed environment, ensuring a memorable outdoor camping experience.

## WEATHER

During February, Pachmarhi experiences cold weather, with temperatures ranging between **2°C** and **18°C**. Participants are therefore advised to carry adequate warm clothing, including jackets, sweaters, thermal wear, woollen caps, gloves, and blankets/sleeping bags, to ensure comfort and protection throughout the programme.



## HOW TO REACH : NATIONAL ADVENTURE INSTITUTE, PACHMARHI, (M.P.)

**Pachmarhi**, popularly known as the "**Queen of Satpura**," is the only hill station in Madhya Pradesh and is well connected by rail and road.



**By Rail:** The nearest railway station is **Pipariya (PPI)**, located approximately **56 km** from Pachmarhi. It is situated on the **Itarsi–Jabalpur railway route**, about 1 hour from Itarsi Junction and 3 hours from Jabalpur. The **Pipariya Bus Stand** is conveniently located just outside the railway station, with regular buses and private vehicles available for Pachmarhi.



**By Road:** Pachmarhi is approximately a **6-hour drive from Bhopal**.

Regular state transport buses and private taxis operate from major cities, including Bhopal, Itarsi, and Pipariya.



**Local Transport:** From the Pachmarhi Bus Stand, the **National Adventure Institute (NAI), Pachmarhi** is located approximately **5 km away**. Private jeeps, taxis, and local transport are readily available at nominal charges to reach the Institute.

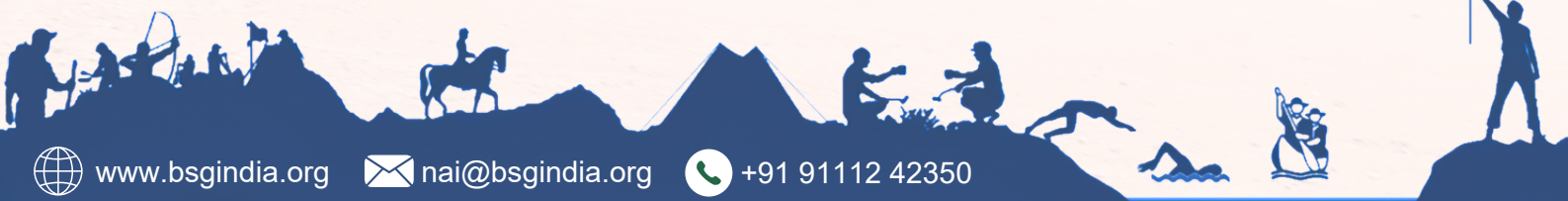

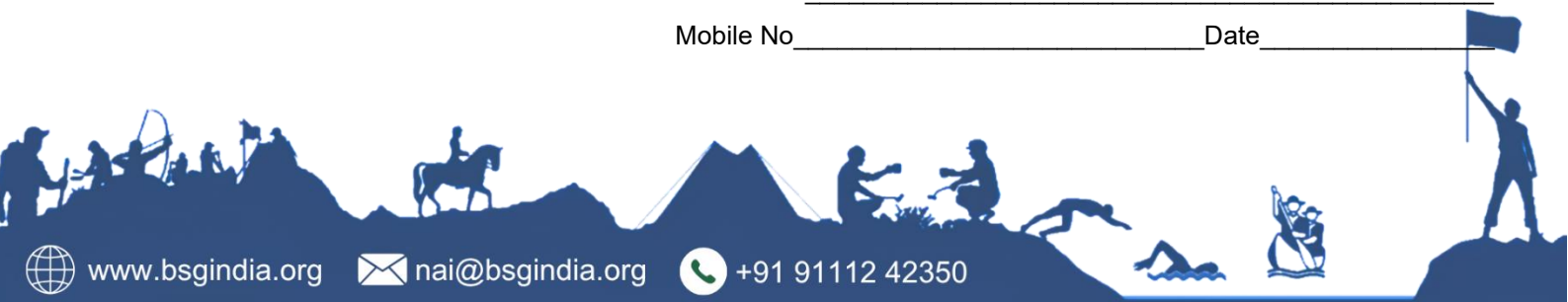
