Venue	National Training Centre, Pachmarhi, Madhya Pradesh
Date of Arrival	26 <sup>th</sup> December 2025 before lunch. Registration will start at 10.00 hrs. in proper uniform. <b>Late comers will not be admitted.</b>

<b>Date of Departure</b>	30 <sup>th</sup> December 2025 after Lunch. Return reservation to be made accordingly. Participants will not be allowed to leave early
<b>Who can participate</b>	Rovers/Rangers and Unit Leaders between 15 to 40 years of age.
<b>Quota</b>	01 – Rover, 01 - Ranger and 01- Unit Leader total - 03  <b>Note: For Rovers, Rangers and Unit Leaders BSG UID No. is mandatory.</b>
<b>Contribution towards Scout /Guide welfare fund</b>	Rs. 350/- per head is to be contributed during registration as Scout/Guide Welfare Fund by each participant i.e. Rovers, Rangers and Adult Leaders.
<b>What to bring</b>	Two sets of correct and complete uniforms as per APRO Part II / III, CLAP T shirt and Jacket, Toilet requisites, Personal dress, Traditional Costumes for Cultural Programmes and Camp Fire, notebook, pen, colour/sketch pens for competitions, water bottle etc.
<b>Financial Assistance</b>	02nd Sleeper Class Train fare and actual ordinary Bus fare by Govt./Private bus will be reimbursed by the National Headquarters on production of Train and bus ticket in original. Bus fare will be paid for the shortest route where there are no train services. <b>Deluxe Volvo Buses or taxi/auto fare is not admissible. Tatkal Charges will not be paid. Participant from Railway States should travel by Railway Passes as per Rules.</b>
<b>How to reach</b>	Pachmarhi is located on the Mumbai Jabalpur route, between Itarsi and Jabalpur Station. Pipariya is the nearest Railway station from Pachmarhi. The distance from Pipariya to Pachmarhi is 56 k.m. Buses are available from Pipariya to Pachmarhi. Numbers of private jeeps are also available. The Bharat Scouts & Guides, NTC is just 5 k.m. from Pachmarhi bus stand. Local Conveyance are available. Those who are coming by private Jeep can directly come up to NTC. 
given to those who have demonstrated dedication and experience in promoting environmental sustainability.


