ARRIVAL: FORENOON OF THE FIRST DAY & **DEPARTURE:** AFTER LUNCH ON THE LAST DAY

For the booking of seats: Scout Guide Welfare Fund ₹. 500/- per head is to be paid in advance which is non – refundable but can be adjusted in other programmes within the same financial year. The Booking confirmation will be informed after receiving of registration fee. For direct deposit through Bank, the Bank charges will be borne by the candidate / Institution. To motivate cashless transactions, participants can do online Transactions/IMPS/ RTGS/NEFT/ Others using following details: -

(Original Bank Pay- In – Slip should be submitted along with the applications at the time of Registration.)

Booking will be made on "**First Come First Serve Basis**". Selection Letter will be sent on receipt of Scout Guide Welfare Fund as registration fee ₹ 500/- per head. The balance amount of **₹4500/- per head** must be remitted via online bank transfer at least fifteen days before the Camp.

Rs.5000/- Per head to be remitted toward **Scout Guide Welfare Fund (This will cover Accommodation, Food, Souvenir Items and Activities)**

The original Application, Medical & Risk Institutional certificate should be produced at the time of Registration, without these mandatory documents participants will not be admitted. **Each Participant will be awarded National Level Participation Certificate on successful completion of the programme.**

Note: No one is permitted to stay in the camp without Registration and Medical Certificate. No age limit for escort teacher but he/she should be physically & medically fit. Preference may be given to under 50 years of age.

Eligibility (Who can participate) : The programme is open to members of The Bharat Scouts and Guides, educational institutions, adventure clubs, well-wishers of the organizations, and other youth organizations interested in adventure activities.



Participants should be in the age group of 12 to 45 years and must be Physically and medically fit and can bear the strain of adventure and related activities. Individuals may also participate independently with valid Government identity proof.

Programmes: Adventure Activities – Rock Climbing, Rappelling, Valley Crossing, Rope Climbing, Archery Shooting, Trekking and visit to places of interest and snow site like Solang Valley, Tal Tunnel etc., and many fun bases and study of flora & fauna.



Local Sightseeing: -

Nature Study & Trekking, Camping, Leadership Training, Scouting Beginners Course, Tour to Jagat Sukh, Hidamba Temple, Manali City, Solang Valley/Golaba, Atal Tunnel etc. Daily Camp Fire at night is another attraction of the programme.

What to Bring: The participants will bring following materials along with them.

- ❖ 01 No. of Stamp size color photograph (recent one).
- ❖ Water Bottle, Torch, etc.
- ❖ Note book, Pen, First Aid Kit, Cold Cream and Odomas etc.
- ❖ Sport Shoes, Extra Pairs of Socks & Slippers.
- ❖ Plate, Glass, Spoon, Full sleeves T-Shirt, Jeans and Track-Suits, Warm clothing's, extra wearing cloths and costumes for cultural items.
- ❖ One set of correct and complete uniform as per APRO part II & III. (for Scouts & Guides only).
- ❖ Temperature will be cool in night. Warm Bedding/Sleeping Bag is recommended.
- ❖ Any other items as per the need of the individual.
- ❖ Rucksack/Backpack for carrying day to day material.
- ❖ Personal Medicines if any.



Risk Management - The Bharat Scouts and Guides take every care of the participants sincerely, but **The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Youth Adventure Institute** will not be responsible for any accident, illness or injury during the programme. The escorting teachers should take extra precaution/care of their students before, during and after the camp.



Accommodation - Accommodation will be provided in Tents.

Weather - Winter temperatures range between 5°C and 12°C, while summer temperatures generally range from 15°C to 25°C; participants are advised to carry clothing accordingly, including sufficient warm clothing's during winter.

How to reach - Base Campsite, Sarsai, Manali Himachal Pradesh.

- Nearest Railway station is Chandigarh. Direct buses are available from New Delhi and Chandigarh to Manali.
- Get down at 15 Miles Iron Bridge before arriving Manali Bus Stand. A vehicle will be ready to receive and to transport the participants to the Samrila Camps, Sarsai. The Campsite is about 1.5 KM from 15 Miles Iron Bridge.

आगमन: प्रथम दिवस के पूर्वाह्न में प्रस्थान: अंतिम दिवस के दोपहर भोजन के पश्चात

सीटों के आरक्षण हेतु: स्काउट गाइड वेलफेयर फंड के अंतर्गत प्रत्येक प्रतिभागी ₹500/- अग्रिम रूप से जमा करना अनिवार्य है। यह राशि वापसी योग्य नहीं होगी, किन्तु उसी वित्तीय वर्ष के अन्य कार्यक्रमों में समायोजित की जा सकती है।

बुकिंग की पुष्टि पंजीकरण शुल्क प्राप्त होने के पश्चात सूचित की जाएगी। प्रत्येक बैंक जमा की स्थिति में बैंक शुल्क अभ्यर्थी/संस्था द्वारा वहन किया जाएगा।

सीटों का आरक्षण "पहले आएँ, पहले पाएँ" के आधार पर किया जाएगा। प्रत्येक प्रतिभागी ₹500/- पंजीकरण शुल्क के रूप में स्काउट गाइड वेलफेयर फंड प्राप्त होने पर चयन पत्र जारी किया जाएगा। शेष ₹4500/- प्रत्येक प्रतिभागी को राशि शिविर प्रारंभ होने से कम-से-कम पंद्रह दिन पूर्व ऑनलाइन बैंक ट्रांसफर के माध्यम से जमा करना अनिवार्य होगा।

प्रत्येक प्रतिभागी कुल ₹5000/- स्काउट गाइड वेलफेयर फंड के अंतर्गत जमा किए जाएंगे। इसमें आवास, भोजन, स्मृति-चिह्न तथा गतिविधियों का व्यय सम्मिलित रहेगा।

पंजीकरण के समय मूल आवेदन पत्र, चिकित्सा प्रमाणपत्र एवं जोखिम प्रमाणपत्र प्रस्तुत करना अनिवार्य होगा। इन आवश्यक दस्तावेजों के बिना प्रतिभागियों को प्रवेश नहीं दिया जाएगा। **कार्यक्रम के सफल समापन पर प्रत्येक प्रतिभागी को राष्ट्रीय स्तर का सहभागिता प्रमाणपत्र प्रदान किया जाएगा।**

पात्रता (कौन भाग ले सकते हैं):



यह कार्यक्रम भारत स्काउट्स एवं गाइड्स के सदस्यों, शैक्षणिक संस्थानों, एडवेंचर क्लबों, संगठन के शुभचिंतकों तथा साहसिक गतिविधियों में रुचि रखने वाले अन्य युवा संगठनों के सदस्यों के लिए खुला है।

प्रतिभागियों की आयु 12 से 45 वर्ष के मध्य होनी चाहिए तथा वे शारीरिक एवं चिकित्सकीय रूप से स्वस्थ हों, ताकि वे साहसिक एवं संबंधित गतिविधियों के तनाव एवं चुनौतियों को सहन कर सकें। व्यक्ति वैध सरकारी पहचान पत्र के साथ स्वतंत्र रूप से भी कार्यक्रम में भाग ले सकते हैं।

कार्यक्रम साहसिक गतिविधियाँ: रॉक क्लाइम्बिंग, रैपलिंग, वैली क्रॉसिंग, रोप क्लाइम्बिंग, तीरंदाजी, ट्रेकिंग तथा सोलंग वैली, अटल टनल आदि जैसे दर्शनीय एवं हिमस्थलों का भ्रमण। इसके अतिरिक्त विभिन्न मनोरंजक गतिविधियाँ एवं वनस्पति एवं जीव-जंतुओं का अध्ययन भी कार्यक्रम का हिस्सा होगा।



स्थानीय भ्रमण:

प्रकृति अध्ययन एवं ट्रेकिंग, कैंपिंग, नेतृत्व प्रशिक्षण, स्काउटिंग बिगिनर्स कोर्स, जगत सुख, हिडिम्बा मंदिर, मनाली शहर, सोलंग वैली / गुलाबा, अटल टनल आदि का भ्रमण कराया जाएगा। प्रतिदिन रात्रि में आयोजित कैंप फायर कार्यक्रम भी इस कार्यक्रम का एक विशेष आकर्षण होगा।

साथ लाने योग्य सामग्री: प्रतिभागियों को निम्नलिखित सामग्री अपने साथ लानी होगी।

- ❖ 01 पासपोर्ट आकार का कलर फोटोग्राफ।
- ❖ पानी की बोतल, टॉर्च आदि।
- ❖ नोटबुक, पेन, प्राथमिक उपचार किट, कोल्ड क्रीम एवं ओडोमॉस आदि।
- ❖ स्पोर्ट्स शूज, अतिरिक्त मोजे एवं चप्पल।
- ❖ प्लेट, गिलास, चम्मच, फुल स्लीव टी-शर्ट, जींस एवं ट्रैक-सूट, गर्म कपड़े, अतिरिक्त पहनने के कपड़े तथा सांस्कृतिक कार्यक्रम हेतु वैशभूषा।
- ❖ एपीआरओ भाग-2 एवं 3 के अनुसार सही एवं पूर्ण यूनिफॉर्म का एक सेट (केवल स्काउट्स एवं गाइड्स हेतु)।
- ❖ रात्रि में तापमान ठंडा रहेगा, अतः गर्म बिस्तर/स्लीपिंग बैग लाने की सलाह दी जाती है।
- ❖ व्यक्तिगत आवश्यकता के अनुसार अन्य आवश्यक सामग्री।
- ❖ दैनिक उपयोग की सामग्री रखने हेतु रक्सैक/बैकपैक।
- ❖ यदि आवश्यक हो तो व्यक्तिगत दवाइयाँ।



जोखिम प्रबंधन: भारत स्काउट्स एवं गाइड्स प्रतिभागियों की सुरक्षा एवं देखभाल हेतु हर संभव ध्यान रखता है, किन्तु कार्यक्रम के दौरान किसी भी दुर्घटना, बीमारी अथवा चोट के लिए **भारत स्काउट्स एवं गाइड्स, राष्ट्रीय युवा साहसिक संस्थान** उत्तरदायी नहीं होगा। एस्कॉर्ट शिक्षक अपने विद्यार्थियों की शिविर से पूर्व, शिविर के दौरान तथा शिविर के पश्चात विशेष सावधानी एवं देखभाल सुनिश्चित करें।



आवास व्यवस्था: आवास की व्यवस्था टेंटों में की जाएगी।

मौसम: शीतकाल में तापमान लगभग 5° डिग्री से 12° डिग्री के मध्य रहता है, जबकि ग्रीष्मकाल में सामान्यतः 15° डिग्री से 25° डिग्री के बीच रहता है। अतः प्रतिभागियों को मौसम के अनुसार पर्याप्त वस्त्र साथ लाने की सलाह दी जाती है, विशेष रूप से शीतकाल में पर्याप्त गर्म कपड़े अवश्य रखें।

कैसे पहुँचें – बेस कैंपसाइट, सरसई, मनाली, हिमाचल प्रदेश

- निकटतम रेलवे स्टेशन चंडीगढ़ है। नई दिल्ली एवं चंडीगढ़ से मनाली के लिए सीधी बस सेवाएँ उपलब्ध हैं।
- मनाली बस स्टैंड पहुँचने से पूर्व "15 माइल्स आयरन ब्रिज" पर उतरें। प्रतिभागियों को प्राप्त करने तथा समरीला कैंप्स, सरसई तक पहुँचाने हेतु वाहन की व्यवस्था उपलब्ध रहेगी। कैंपसाइट "15 माइल्स आयरन ब्रिज" से लगभग 1.5 कि.मी. की दूरी पर स्थित है।

Preamble-

The President of the Indian Union has been graciously pleased to issue a special certificate to eligible Scout/ Guide/ Rover/ Ranger who qualifies for the Rashtrapati / President Scout/ Guide/ Rover/ Ranger Certificate Examination after serving as a Rajya Puraskar Scout/Guide/ Rover/Ranger for at least twelve months (one year).

The Chief National Commissioner shall issue suitable directives from time to time with respect to badge, tests, syllabi, etc., and ensure the standard of skills involved.

A Rajya Puraskar Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger served for a year, who fulfils the required prerequisites and has undergone qualifying State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Certificate, will be tested at National Level for Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate on behalf of the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters by the 3rd party testing agency as per direction of the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India under the supervision of the National Board for Testing Scouting/Guiding Skills constituted by the Chief National Commissioner.

The National Board of Testing Scouting/Guiding Skills shall consist of a Chairman and at least two members who have been Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger or held warrant of appointment earlier and people of repute and standing who accept the offer of the Bharat Scouts and Guides as such.

The National Board for Testing Scouting/Guiding Skills is responsible for controlling, supervising, and advising third-party testing agency from time to time with respect to the conduct of examination as well as monitoring the State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Certificate.

The Chief National Commissioner shall be the final authority to recommend and grant Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate.

The schedule of the National Level Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate Examination shall be communicated to the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India. Ministry of Youth Affairs may depute supervisors/observers at various examination centres.

1. METHODOLOGY: -

A circular along with the guidelines to conduct the Rashtrapati / President Scout/ Guide/ Rover/Ranger Certificate Examination shall be issued by the National Headquarters to all the State Associations of the Bharat Scouts and Guides.

The National Level Rashtrapati/President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate Examination will be conducted in two parts i.e., State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati/President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate Examination and National Level Examination for Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate.

State-Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Certificate will be organised by the State Associations **under the supervision of the National Headquarters** and recommend the candidate for the National Level Examination for Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate.

Recommended candidates from the State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate and whose online application is found eligible will be invited for the National Level Examination for Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate to be conducted by the authorized Third Party Testing agency under the supervision of National Board for Testing Scouting/Guiding Skills.

The National Examination will be conducted online with multiple-type questions for a duration of about 60 to 90 minutes or as the case may be. The syllabus for the online examination will be based on the syllabus prescribed in A.P.R.O. II/III and on Current Affairs/General Knowledge.

The Assistant Director (Awards & Competitions) is responsible for issuing the circulars, monitoring State Level Testing Camps, online registration for the National Level Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate Examination, supervision of testing centers, etc. with assistance of other Assistant Directors/ROC's.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- **Scouts/Guides**

A Rajya Puraskar Scout/ Guide on completion of at least **13 years 06 months of age** and have completed 12 months' service as a Rajya Puraskar Scout /Guide and qualified the State level testing camp for Rashtrapati / President Certificate is eligible for National Level Rashtrapati / President Scout/ Guide Certificate Examination. He/She is eligible to attend the State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Certificate up to the age of 18 years only.

- **Rovers/Rangers**

A Rajya Puraskar Rover/Ranger on completion of **17 years 06 months** and served one year as a Rajya Puraskar Rover/Ranger and has qualified the State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Certificate is eligible for the National Level Rashtrapati / President Rover /Ranger Certificate Examination.

A Rover/Ranger who has completed 25 years of age will not be eligible for State/National Level examination for Rashtrapati / President Rover/ Ranger Certificate. The State Chief Commissioner can extend the age limit for 3 years provided the exemption is applied by the candidate and approved by the State Chief Commissioner before attaining 25 years of age (Ref: APRO Part-II, Chapter-III, Rule-1 (a) and APRO-III, Chapter-III, Rule -1).

3. REGISTRATION: -

The Warranted Advanced Trained Scout Master/Guide Captain (as the case may be) shall recommend the Rajya Puraskar Scout/Guide and the warranted Basic Trained Rover Scout Leader/Ranger Leader (as the case may be) shall recommend Rajya Puraskar Rover/Ranger who has completed the requirement of the Rashtrapati / President Certificate in the prescribed online registration form to the State through District Association.

Registration for the Rashtrapati / President Scout / Guide/ Rover/ Ranger Certificate Examination-2023, 2024 & 2025 will be accepted **only through online submission** on the Rashtrapati / President Award Application Portal. Applicants may access the Application portal through BSG website: www.bsgindia.org

A separate circular will be issued for the Over Aged Candidates for the years 2023 and 2024.

State Associations must ensure that all online application forms are approved on or before **30th May 2026**. Applications approved after this date will be considered for the next year, i.e., **2026**.

4. STATE-LEVEL TESTING CAMP FOR RASHTRAPATI / PRESIDENT SCOUT / GUIDE / ROVER / RANGER CERTIFICATE:

Schedule of State-Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate from each state should reach the Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations) at NHQ by **10th July 2026**. The State Association is responsible to organize the Testing Camp as per the timeline fixed by **the National Headquarters**.

The State Association is responsible to organize State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Certificate as per the schedule and timeline submitted to NHQ. The timeline will not be extended further. The ideal size of the number of participants for Testing Camps will be 150 but should not exceed 200 in each camp.

➤ Procedure:

- Registration form of Rashtrapati / President Scout/ Guide/ Rover/ Ranger Certificate Examination will be accepted through BSG **Award Application Portal only**.
- Applicant can access the Application portal via BSG website www.bsgindia.org
- BSG UID Number is **Mandatory**. Without valid UID Number **application cannot** be submitted.
- Candidates shall Fill up **Online application** through, the online Portal for the registration of Rashtrapati / President Scout/ Guide/ Rover/ Ranger Certificate Examination.
- Aadhar Card is mandatory. Without upload of the Aadhar Card Application cannot be submitted.
- State Association shall scrutinize online applications through portal, verify all the credentials & attached document and approve with in the timeline.

- A nominated panel under the supervision of Assistant Director (Regional Desk-State Association) will verify the online applications / documents and finalize the Eligible List of the candidates.
- State Association will arrange the testing Camps and invite the eligible candidates after receiving the eligibility list from Assistant Director (Regional Desk-State Association) for the State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Certificate.
- Only on **final confirmation of eligible candidates** for the State Level Testing Camp by the Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations), the list of eligible candidates is to be sent to the respective District Association by SHQ.
- Only eligible candidates will be invited to the State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati S/G/R/R Certificate examination organize by the concerned State Association at their well-established Training Centres.
- State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Certificate will be organized at the well-equipped training centre under the supervision of the Assistant Director (Awards & Competitions) and Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations).
- The panel of examiners will consist of 50% from the host state and 50% from other State Associations to be deputed by the Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations). Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations) may depute an observer to visit the testing camp to ensure standard & transparency of testing. Travelling expenses of invited staff and observers deputed by the Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations) will have to be borne by the host State Association.
- Within three days of completing the State Level Testing Camp for the Rashtrapati / President S/G/R/R Certificate Examination, the State Association must email the following in the prescribed proforma supplied by NHQ to the Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations) with a copy to the Assistant Director (Awards & Competitions):
 - ❖ A scanned copy of the consolidated result sheet and Excel sheet
 - ❖ The list of qualified candidates in Excel sheet
 - ❖ The information format in Excel sheet

Additionally, a hard copy of the same documents along with the **Individual candidate details form** must be sent to NHQ by post or courier within one week of completion each Testing Camp.

Note:- SOC's concerned to ensure that the Testing camp documents are submitted within the timeline to avoid cancellation of the Testing Camp

- Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations) will scrutinize the qualified list along with the consolidated Result sheet and revert with RHQ enrolment number to the State Association with a copy to Assistant Director (Awards & Competitions)
- After receiving enrolment number from the Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations) the respective State Association shall declare the Result of

the State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati / President Certificate examination within five days.

➤ **Leader of the Camp and Panel of Examiners:-**

Panel of the examiner to be formed by Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations) and shall consist of 50% from the host state and 50% from other states. The proposals of examiners from the host State is to be proposed by respective SOCs.

The Panel of Examiners shall consist of Leader Trainers, Assistant Leader Trainers, and Senior HWB Holders of the concerned section. The State Organising Commissioner of the respective States will be the Leader of the Testing Camp. He /She can nominate the Assistant State Organising Commissioner of the concerned wing to be the LOC if SOC is not available. State Training Commissioner of the concerned wing, if he/she is ALT/LT may also be nominated to be the LOC of the Testing Camp if SOC is not available provided authorization is issued by the competent authority of the State Association. The SOC/STC/ASOC is entirely responsible to coordinate all the arrangements of the camp and is accountable for conducting/organizing the testing camp and finalizing the result.

➤ **Duties of The State Organising Commissioner/Leader of the State Level Testing Camp: -**

- To invite sufficient staff within and outside the State with the approval of Assistant Director (Regional Desk & State Associations) as per the expected number of participants in the ratio of 1:20.
- Organizing and conducting the Testing Camp smoothly.
- Arranging all the material for the testing camp with the support of the host State.
- To ensure Testing Camp will be on Scout/Guide Skill, Proficiency Badges, Checking of Log Books, etc. as per requirements prescribed in A.P.R.O. Part-II/III from Pravesh to Rashtrapati Badge.
- To maintain standard and Transparency in the Testing.
- The Leader should ensure that he /she works as an examiner in at least one base.
- To ensure that the score sheet and result sheet as per proforma supplied by the National Headquarters is prepared. The entire Base score sheets will be signed by the base in charge and the leader of the testing camp.
- The final result sheet should be prepared in the presence of all the examiners and their signatures are obtained and well documented at the State Headquarters.
- For the purpose of Testing, generally, the base method shall be followed. The Chief Examiner will depute examiners in consultation with the Leader in each base.
- The Leader of the camp will announce the Daily Routine.
- The consolidated/Final result sheet will be prepared by the Leader with the signature of all the examiners, Chief Examiner, Tabulator, and LOC on the last day of the testing camp without any overwriting.

➤ **Chief Examiner: -**

There will be a Chief Examiner selected among the **senior and experienced examiners from the Panel of Examiners** from the **invited States only**. Chief Examiner will assist the Leader in conducting impartial testing as per guidelines.

➤ **Conduct of State-Level Testing Camp : -**

The minimum – qualifying standard for recommendation to National Level Examination for Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate in State Level Testing will be **80%** in all subjects for Scout & Guide and Rover & Ranger.

- Maximum mark for each subject is out of 10.
- The State Headquarters is responsible to get online applications duly filled by the candidates in the stipulated timeline as per the NHQ circular.
- Registration Fee for the State Level Testing Camp may be decided by the State Association if any.
- **The State Level Testing Camp shall be conducted only in a well-equipped Training Centre preferably under canvas and not in School or Permanent Building.**
- The Host States should ensure all the physical arrangements such as Testing Equipment, the place for various Test bases, proper seating arrangements, sanitation, electricity, and water facility.
- Lodging & Boarding including the safety & security of participants is the responsibility of the State Association.
- The Medium of the Test will be Hindi or English. However, the candidates who prefer to take the oral test in Regional Language will be allowed if so desired. The States shall help to provide translators for the same if required by the examiner.
- Testing Camp will be for full 05 days and residential in nature. Candidates will not be allowed to leave during the camp for any reason.
- If the number of candidates in the State Level Testing Camp for Rashtrapati President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger certificate is below 30 in number and the State has an adequate number of the panel of examiners, the Testing Camp can be organized for the duration of 03 full days. Subsequently, if the number of candidates is less and the State would like to depute the prospective candidates for the State Level Testing Camp to another State Association, decision of the LOC during State Level Testing Camp will be taken as authentic and final in all respects. All Testing documents of the candidates will be retained in the custody of the LOC of the host State Association
- Unsuccessful candidates in the State Level Testing Camp need to fill fresh application for the next year if his/her age permits.

5. NATIONAL LEVEL EXAMINATION FOR RASHTRAPATI / PRESIDENT SCOUT/GUIDE/ROVER/RANGER CERTIFICATE:-

- The State Association shall instruct eligible candidates to fill out the online application form on the Third-Party Testing Agency portal through the BSG website (www.bsgindia.org) and to remit the prescribed registration fee as announced.
- The qualified candidate is responsible to ensure his/her registration online for the National level online Examination (CBT).
- It is mandatory to upload photo in uniform while applying for online examination.
- Admit cards will be issued by the Third-Party Testing Agency to registered and eligible candidates, indicating the Examination Centre, date, and time of the examination.
- The 03rd party testing agency is responsible for online testing and preparation of results.
- Result declared by the third Party Testing Agency shall be submitted to the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports through the Hon'ble Chief National Commissioner.
- Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, is the Nodal Ministry for Scouting/Guiding in India, will recommend the result to the President's Secretariat
- On the approval of the President's Secretariat, National Headquarters will declare the result.
- A certificate is to be produced as per the proforma issue by NHQ along with a stamp paper of Rs 100/- duly certified by the oath commissioner for any corrections in the name after announcement of Merit list of the National Level Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate Online Examination within a week.
- Maximum of 2000 Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger shall be declared qualified for National Level Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Certificate Examination. Out of these two thousand successful candidates, a total of 120 top achievers (as suggested by the President Secretariat & Ministry of Youth Affairs) shall be selected annually for the Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Award Certificate. Minimum qualifying marks will be **80%** which may be further revised by the National Board of Testing Scouting/Guiding Skills as may be deemed fit.
- On approval, the 04 (Four) exemplary (on the basis of smartness and good order) Top Achievers (S/G/R/R) will be selected for Rashtrapati / President Award in a special ceremony as and when finalized by the President's Secretariat.
- Other Certificates duly signed by the Chief National Commissioner of the Bharat Scouts and Guides will be presented by the State to the parents of the Scouts/Guides, Rovers/Rangers who will further present to the Scouts/Guides, Rovers/Rangers in a ceremonial function as decided by the State Association.
- Candidate who appeared the CBT examination but not able to score under the top achievers i.e. Merit list may re-appear the National Level Rashtrapati / President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger Online Examination after re-applying through the State Association provided he/she is eligible as per the age criteria envisaged in A.P.R.O. Part-II & Part-III. He/she need not appear State Level Testing Camp once again.

6. WHAT TO BRING BY THE CANDIDATE: -

A. At State Level Testing Camp :

- Age Proof- Certificate issued by the Head of Institution where the applicant is studying, in case the candidate has appeared for Board examination, photocopy of the Board certificate duly attested should be submitted in the State Level Testing Camp during registration for verification.
- Proficiency Badge Certificates from authorized Examiners appointed by Local Association/District Association.
- It is obligatory for all the registered candidates to bring with them Individual Progress Card, and Log books. There is no bar for preparing Log Books in the regional Language.
- Relevant Certificates, Reports, and Materials related to testing of Proficiency Badges/ Skills.
- **Printed Individual Details Form to be to be carried and submitted at the time of registration (Individual Details form to be downloaded from the portal).**
- All the candidates should be in correct and complete uniform as per APRO Part-II / III at the time of registration in the camp.

B. At the National Level Examination:

- Admit card issued by a third-party testing agency. Candidate should verify the details in the admit card once received. If any error is observed in the name, it should be immediately informed within a week and NHQ shall not be held responsible if any error is observed after declaration of the Merit list.
- Proof of identity- Aadhar card/Scout-Guide identity card issued by the state/school /passport or ID issued by central/state govt.
- Candidates will not be permitted to appear for the CBT Examination **without wearing the Scout/Guide uniform.**

7. Examination Fee:

Examination Fees- A candidate appearing for National Level Rashtrapati / President Scout/ Guide/ Rover/ Ranger Certificate **CBT** Examination (Rashtrapati Scout/ Guide/ Rover/ Ranger Pramanpatra Pariksha) shall have to pay the prescribed examination fee at the time of registration as may be decided from time to time by the National Headquarters.

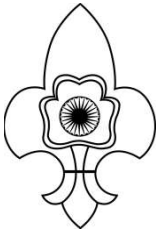

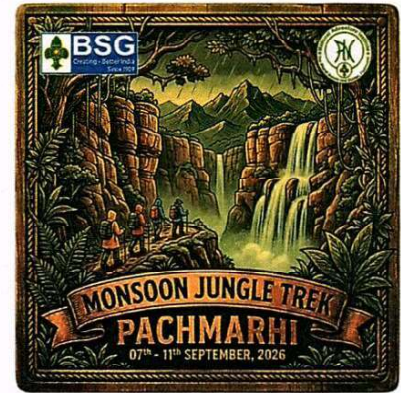

The nearest Railway station is PIPARIYA, which is one-hour journey from Itrasi Junction towards Jabalpur (about 3 hour's journey from Jabalpur towards Itarsi) in Itarsi- Allahabad Railway line. The distance from Pipariya to Pachmarhi is 56 km. The bust stand at Pipariya is just outside the Pipariya Railway Station. Transport buses are available. Numbers of private jeeps are also available on nominal rates from Pachmarhi bus stand to our Institute which is just 5 km away from bus stand. From Bhopal to Pachmarhi, 6 hours journey by road.
