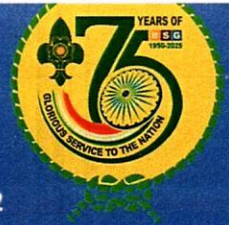

 - group singing (patriotic, folk, inspirational songs)
 - Instrumental performances

 - Speech, debate, storytelling, or poetry recitation
 - Topics aligned with leadership, environment, and social responsibility
5. **Digital Content Creation -**
 - Short films, reels, vlogs, or digital posters
 - Themes: “My Journey in BSG”, “Climate Action”, “Community Impact”

Levels of Competition

- **Unit/District Level:** Initial screening and selection

- **State Level:** Finalists compete at a grand state event. The State Association will issue the Award and recognition at their own level.
- **National Showcase:** The best two (02) entries from each category (Sl. No. 01 to 05), as nominated by the State Associations, shall be submitted to the National Headquarters by 10th June 2026 for the National-level competition. Upon receipt of the entries, the National Headquarters will organise the National-level competition at New Delhi in the month of August 2026.
