

Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters!

The National Road Safety Week is observed across the country every year from **11th to 17th January** with the objective of fostering awareness about safe road practices and reducing the number of accidents, injuries, and fatalities. This initiative emphasizes the importance of disciplined driving, pedestrian safety, emergency preparedness, and promoting responsible road behaviour.

India has a large population of road users, including two-wheeler and four-wheeler travelers. Therefore, it is essential to educate and spread awareness among the public regarding road safety rules and responsible behavior on the roads.

🎯 Objectives of National Road Safety Week 2026

- To **minimize road accidents, injuries, and loss of life** by strengthening awareness and compliance with road safety rules.
- To **promote responsible road behaviour** among all citizens, encouraging the consistent use of safety equipment such as helmets, seat belts, and child restraints.
- To **implement and reinforce preventive approaches**, best safety practices, and evidence-based measures aimed at reducing road risks for drivers, riders, and pedestrians.
- To **educate and empower road users** to avoid unsafe practices such as over-speeding, careless overtaking, distracted driving, mobile use while driving, and driving under the influence of alcohol or other substances.

🚦 Suggested Activities to Observe National Road Safety Week 2026


- 🚶 🚶 **Road Safety Awareness March:**
Organize *awareness rally* with placards, slogans, and posters promoting safe road behaviour.

- **Traffic Control Assistance:**
Support local authorities in guiding pedestrians at school crossings or public areas as per training and instructions.
- **Nukkad Natak / Skit:**
Perform a Nukkad Natak/Skit topics like "Don't Drink and Drive," "Follow Traffic Signals," or "Helmet Saves Life."
- **Creative Safety Challenge:**
Organize poster making, slogan writing, badge design, or banner competitions on the theme of road safety.
- **Safety Quiz & Games:**
Conduct quizzes and traffic sign identification activities to test and build road awareness.
- **First Aid & Emergency Response Workshop:**
Trained in basic first aid, CPR awareness, and emergency response during road accidents.
- **Social Media Awareness Drive:**
Create short videos, posters, digital leaflets, or awareness messages and share responsibly using official hashtags.


