Dear Sir/Madam,

As part of the long-term vision and preparations for the 100th Anniversary of the Bharat Scouts and Guides in 2050, it is proposed to initiate a meaningful and engaging activity titled the “**Time Capsule Tomorrow's Treasure.**” The suggested programme for the Diamond Jubilee Celebration for the month of **March 2026**, aligned with **NHQ Circular No. 225/2025 dated 03 October 2025**,



This action aims to involve youth members in preserving memories, aspirations, and the spirit of BSG for future generations.

All State Associations are requested to encourage youth groups (Scouts, Guides, Rovers, and Rangers) to prepare Time Capsules containing items that reflect the present era and their experiences in the movement.

### **Suggested Contents of Time Capsules**

01. Personal letters addressed to future members (to be opened in 2050)
02. Photographs of activities, camps, and events
03. Drawings, creative writings, and messages
04. Memorabilia such as badges, scarves, event souvenirs
05. Notes on current social issues, aspirations, and innovations

### **Guidelines**

01. Each State Association may prepare one or more **Time Capsule Tomorrow's Treasure.**
02. The time capsule may be made of a sturdy plastic bin, a wooden chest, or a stainless-steel canister. The capsule should be durable, waterproof, and properly sealed to ensure the safety of its contents. A record of the contents must be maintained at State level.
03. Capsules should be securely stored at designated locations with proper documentation.

04. Each capsule must be clearly labelled and placed at a State Headquarters/State Training center: **"To be opened in 07<sup>th</sup> November 2050 – Centenary year of the Bharat Scouts and Guides."**

**Objectives:**

- To inspire youth to reflect on their role in nation-building
- To create a historical archive for future generations
- To strengthen emotional connection with the Movement


Each state prepares their time capsule, make videos and share the videos and action pictures on BSG Social handles.

All State Secretaries are requested to circulate this initiative to all District Associations and ensure enthusiastic participation across the State.
