

National Youth Day is observed to spread his message of **harmony, universal brotherhood, self-confidence, and personal improvement** among the younger generation.

All Scouts, Guides, Rovers, Rangers, and Unit Leaders are requested to actively **observe National Youth Day 2026** within their respective communities and institutions. Activities may be organised at the local, district, or state levels, ensuring participation and visible impact on the community.

🌟 To commemorate National Youth Day 2026, the following activities are suggested:

1. 🧠 Quiz Competition on Swami Vivekananda's Life & Teachings

A quiz designed to engage youth in learning about Swami Vivekananda's philosophy, life events, inspiring speeches, and contributions to society.

2. 📖 Book Reading / Storytelling Session on Youth Empowerment

Participants may read inspirational stories, books or short biographies that highlight courage, leadership, and self-development among youth.

3. 🤝 Community Service & Cleanliness Drive (Shramdaan)

Such as cleanliness drives, blood donation camps, and visits to slums, old-age homes, or orphanages to promote empathy and social responsibility.

4. 🎤 Speech & Elocution Competition on Youth Leadership

Participants express their thoughts on themes such as leadership, nation-building, social harmony, and the role of youth in modern India.

5. 🌱 Peace March / Youth Rally on National Unity

A unity march to spread awareness about peace, national integration, and the importance of harmony among diverse communities.

6. 🔥 Adventure-Based Team-Building Games

Fun-filled outdoor adventure games that build teamwork, confidence, physical fitness, and leadership qualities among youth.

7. 🧘 Yoga, Meditation & Wellness Sessions

Sessions promoting physical and mental well-being through guided yoga and meditation.

8. 🛠️ Skill Development Workshops

Workshops focusing on essential life skills, communication, creativity, digital literacy, and leadership.

9. 🏛️ Youth Parliament / Mock Parliament Session

A platform for youth to practice democratic dialogue and understand parliamentary procedures. It helps develop leadership, critical thinking, and informed participation in civic issues.

SUB: OBSERVATION OF NATIONAL GIRL CHILD DAY 24TH JANUARY 2026.

Dear Sir/Madam,

Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters!

National Girl Child Day is observed on **24th January** every year to spread awareness about the inequalities faced by girls in society and to promote the rights of the girl child. The day emphasizes the importance of girls' education, health, safety, and overall empowerment. It also aligns with various campaigns and initiatives of the Government of India, including **Beti Bachao Beti Padhao** and **Save the Girl Child**.

Introduced in **2008** by the **Ministry of Women and Child Development**, the day aims to highlight gender disparities and advocate for equal opportunities for girls. Despite significant progress, gender discrimination continues to affect the lives of girls and women across the nation. Observing this day helps reinforce the commitment to creating a safer, healthier, and more equitable environment for every girl.

Objectives of National Girl Child Day 2026:

➤ **Awareness of Rights**

To make parents, teachers, and communities aware of the equal legal, social, and human rights of girls — including inheritance, property rights, and freedom from violence, exploitation, and discrimination.

➤ **End Gender-Biased Sex Selection**

To combat female foeticide and infanticide by enforcing laws and promoting mindset change so that every girl child is welcomed, valued, and celebrated.

➤ **Promote Education and Skill Development**

To ensure that girls complete their schooling and gain access to quality education, career guidance, and modern skills such as digital literacy, languages, leadership, sports, and vocational training.

➤ **Improve Health and Nutrition**

To raise awareness about anaemia, malnutrition, menstrual hygiene, vaccination, mental health, and other essential aspects of a girl's physical and emotional development.

➤ **Strengthen Safety and Protection**

To promote awareness about protective laws such as the POCSO Act and the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, along with helplines, child protection services, and one-stop centres for girls facing abuse.

➤  **Create Equal Opportunities**

To encourage and support girls' participation in diverse fields where they were historically underrepresented — including defence services, IITs, sports, STEM fields, leadership roles, and entrepreneurship.

Suggested activities to observed the National Girl Child Day 2026 are furnished herewith:

•  **Awareness Rally**

Organize a rally to promote the rights of the girl child and the importance of education, health, nutrition, and safety.

•  **Nukkad Natak (Street Play)**

Perform short plays highlighting issues faced by girls and promoting gender equality.

•  **Promotion of Govt. & State Schemes**

Create awareness about *Beti Bachao Beti Padhao*, *Save the Girl Child*, *Sukanya Samridhi Yojana*, and other girl-child related schemes.

•  **Drawing & Poster Making Competition**

Encourage creativity by having participants design posters on girl child empowerment.

•  **Debate Competition**

Conduct debates on topics related to girls' rights, gender equality, and women's empowerment.


