Suggested Activities – World Environment Day 2026


- **🌱 Tree Plantation Drive**

- **♻️ Waste Management Activity**
Promote segregation of waste (wet & dry) and encourage recycling and reuse practices. Organize competitions or demonstrations on converting waste into useful products.
- **🛑 Plastic-Free Campaign**
Launch awareness drives to reduce single-use plastic. Distribute cloth/jute bags and educate communities about eco-friendly alternatives.

-  **Awareness Rally / Campaign**
Conduct rallies, street plays, or human chains to spread messages about climate change and environmental protection among the general public.
-  **Quiz Competition**
Organize quizzes on environmental issues, climate change, and conservation to enhance knowledge and engagement among Scouts and Guides.
-  **Eco-friendly Workshop**
Arrange workshops on sustainable practices such as composting, organic farming, water conservation, and energy saving techniques.
-  **Cleanliness Drive**
Carry out cleanliness campaigns in parks, riversides, public places, and neighbourhoods to promote hygiene and environmental responsibility.
-  **Climate Action Pledge**



Awareness Activities (3)



Eco-Friendly Habits Poster (24th April):

Create an eco-friendly study space by cleaning your area and organizing it using sustainable practices. You can add a small plant, make use of natural light, and avoid using plastic items. Take before and after photos to show the improvement and share them as instructed.

Action-Based Activities (5)



Waste to Best Activity (30th April):

Reuse old or waste materials such as bottles, boxes, or newspapers to create useful items like pen stands or planters. Carefully show the steps involved in making the item, along with the final product, by taking clear photographs. Share these photos on social media and tag the official @BSGIndia account as per the given instructions.



Cleanliness Drive (02nd April):

Take the initiative to clean a small area such as a park, street, or your school surroundings. Ensure your safety by using gloves and handling waste carefully. Dispose of the collected waste in a proper and responsible manner. Capture before and after photos to clearly show the impact of your efforts. Share the photos on your social media and tag @BSGIndia.



Seed Ball Making Activity (04th May):

Prepare seed balls using soil, compost, and seeds.
