Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters!

We are pleased to inform you that The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters is organizing the **National Level Training of Trainers for the Northern Region under the Youth Led Action on Climate Change (YLACC) project** from 10th to 14th August 2026 at Youth Hostel, Nagrota Jammu, Jammu and Kashmir.

Youth Led Action on Climate Change (YLACC) is a joint initiative of The Bharat Scouts and Guides and the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS) that empowers young people to understand climate change, take climate action, and lead sustainable initiatives in their communities.

The training is intended for **Rovers, Rangers, Unit Leaders, and Trainers** who are passionate about climate action. Participants will be trained on the YLACC curriculum and will further cascade the training within their respective State Associations and local units.

Venue	:	Youth Hostel, Nagrota Jammu, Jammu and Kashmir.
How to Reach	:	Nearest Railway Station: Jammu Tawi (JAT) Nearest Bus Terminal: Jammu Bus Stand Distance: Around 14 Kilometers from Jammu Tawi Railway Station and around 10 Kilometers from Jammu Bus Stand (BC Road). One can take a local mini bus (Matador) from Jammu Tawi Railway Station to Jammu Bus Stand. From there, reach BC Road near KC Cinema, under the Bakshi Nagar Flyover, where regular Matadors are available for Nagrota (on

		NH-44, Jammu–Srinagar National Highway). Get down at the Nagrota Petrol Pump, which is the nearest stop to Youth Hostel Nagrota. The hostel is approximately 300 metres from the petrol pump and can be reached on foot. Rapido services are also available for travelling to Youth Hostel Nagrota.
Who can attend	:	Rovers, Rangers, Unit Leaders/Trainers from any section as selected by state. (Note: Those Rovers, Rangers, Unit Leader/Trainer who have attended the previous training are not eligible for this training.)
Quota Allocation	:	• Rovers: 01; • Rangers: 01; • Unit Leaders/Trainers: 02 • Nominated State Coordinator from State Official (GW): 01 The deputed Rovers, Rangers, Unit Leaders/Trainers must be able to lead the YLACC curriculum in his/her District/State/Region.
Scouts and Guides Welfare Fund	:	Rs. 350/- per head is to be deposited during registration as a Scout/Guide Welfare Fund.
Financial Assistance	:	The National Headquarters will provide free hospitality during the event. 2 nd Sleeper Class train fare and local conveyance will be provided by NHQ on the production of the original tickets with TE bill. Leader Trainers (LTs) and Assistant Leader Trainer (ALTs) are eligible for AC3 Tier train fare (except Rajdhani and Shatabdi express).

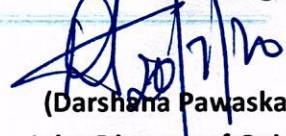

ARRIVAL:

Participants should report at the **Base Campsite, Dev Kids Public School, Katra**, in the **forenoon of the first day**. The campsite is conveniently located **near the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board, Katra, District Reasi, Jammu & Kashmir.**

How to Reach – Base Campsite, Dev Kids Public School, Katra

The **Base Campsite, Dev Kids Public School, Katra**, is conveniently located near the **Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board, Katra, District Reasi, Jammu & Kashmir.** The campsite is situated approximately **2 km from Katra Bus Stand** and **2 km from Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra Railway Station (SVDK).**

DEPARTURE: -

Participants will depart from the Base Campsite, Dev Kids Public School, Katra, after lunch on the last day of the programme.

For the booking of seats: Scout Guide Welfare Fund ₹1,500/- per head is to be paid in advance which is non – refundable but can be adjusted in other programmes within the same financial year.

The Booking confirmation will be informed after receiving of registration fee. For direct deposit through Bank, the Bank charges will be borne by the candidate / Institution. Booking will be made on "**First Come First Serve Basis**". Only 80 trekkers will be permitted in each Programme. Hence proceed registration without waiting and grab the opportunity. Preference may be given to under 55years of age.

Selection Letter will be sent on receipt of Scout Guide Welfare Fund as registration fee ₹ 1,500/- per head. The balance amount of ₹4000/- per head must be remitted via online bank transfer at least fifteen days before the Camp.

₹5,500/- Per head to be remitted toward **Scout Guide Welfare Fund (This will cover Accommodation, Food, Souvenir Items and Activities)**

The original Application, Medical & Risk certificate should be produced at the time of Registration, without these mandatory documents participants will not be admitted. **Each Participant will be awarded National Level Participation Certificate on successful completion of the programme.**

Note: No one is permitted without Registration, Risk and Medical Certificate. The escort teacher if any should be physically & medically fit. Participants will proceed only on receipt of selection letter from NHQ.



Eligibility (Who can participate): The programme is open to members of The Bharat Scouts and Guides, educational institutions, adventure clubs, well-wishers of the organizations, and other youth organizations interested in adventure activities.

Participants should be in the age group of **16 to 45 years** and must be Physically and medically fit and can bear the strain of adventure and related activities. Individuals may also participate independently with valid Government identity proof.

Programmes & Activities:

Visit to Maa Vaishno Devi Temple, Trekking & Nature Walks, Camping, Nature Study & Environmental Awareness, Study of Flora and Fauna Observation, Leadership & Team Building Activities, Camp Fire & Cultural activities and Sightseeing and local area exploration etc.



What to Bring: The participants will bring following materials along with them.

- ❖ **UPPER BODY CLOTHING:** Full Sleeve T-Shirts (Quick Dry), Warm Fleece Jacket, Down Jacket, Waterproof & Windproof Jacket/Raincoat/Poncho all items to be carried as per need of the individual **but Mandatory**.
- ❖ **LOWER BODY CLOTHING:** Innerwear (undergarments), Trekking Pants (Quick Dry), Thermal Inner Lower, Track Pant for Night Stay, Waterproof Lower/Rain Pant all items to be carried as per need of the individual **but Mandatory**.
- ❖ **FOOTWEAR:** Good quality Trekking Shoes with Grip and waterproofed 02-03 pairs of Cotton and Woollen socks, slippers 01 and Grater 01 pair each.
- ❖ **HEAD & HAND PROTECTION:** Woollen Cap - 01, P-Cap – 01, Waterproofed Gloves – 01 pair and Woollen Glovers – 01 pair
- ❖ **PERSONAL ESSENTIALS:** Backpack with capacity of (50 to 60 Liters), Day Pack (20 to 30 Liters) with rain cover, water bottle, Trekking Pole, Torch/Headlamp with extra batteries, Personal Toiletries, Quick Dry Towel, Lip Balm, Moisturizer to be carried. Pain relief spray, Band-Aid, ORS, Note book, Pen, First Aid Kit or personal medicines if any, Plate, Glass, Spoon etc. Temperature will be very cool in night. Warm Sleeping Bag is highly recommended. Participants are advised **not to carry suitcases or trolley bags**. Only a **rucksack/backpack** is recommended for trekking. **Mandatory items to be carried** - Sunglasses (UV Protected) and Sunscreen Lotion (SPF40+)



NB: The above items are Mandatory. If any participant fails to carry the recommended materials individually, the Bharat Scouts and Guides is not responsible.

Risk Management: The Bharat Scouts and Guides take every care of the participants sincerely, but **The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Youth Adventure Institute** will not be responsible for any accident, illness or injury during the programme. The escorting teachers/individual should take extra precaution/care of their students/themselves before, during and after the camp.

Accommodation - Accommodation will be provided in Dormitories/Hotels on sharing basis with basic facilities suitable for trekking and nature study programme.



Weather - Winter temperatures range between 13°C and -15°C, while summer temperatures generally range from 5°C to 20°C; participants are advised to carry clothing accordingly, including sufficient warm clothing's.

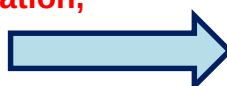
