SUBJECT: FORMAL ADVISORY FOR GIRLS AND WOMEN TO WEAR SHIRT AND PANT AS OFFICIAL UNIFORM OF THE BHARAT SCOUTS AND GUIDES

Dear State Chief Commissioner,

Warm greetings from the National Headquarters!

It has come to the notice of the National Headquarters that several girls and women members of the Bharat Scouts and Guides are expressing their interest in wearing the official Scout uniform comprising shirt and pant, in keeping with their comfort, dignity, and evolving societal norms.

However, in the absence of a formal circular, this inclusive and progressive choice is not being consistently acknowledged or supported across State Associations, leading to confusion and unnecessary restrictions.

This is to formally clarify and reaffirm that:

Girls and women in The Bharat Scouts and Guides who opt to wear the Shirt-Pant uniform are fully permitted to wear the official BSG Steel Grey Shirt and Navy Blue Trousers. Members of the Scout Wing shall wear the WOSM badge, while members of the Guide Wing shall wear the WAGGGS badge, The Badges shall be worn on the shirt pockets.

This decision was:

- Publicly announced by the Chief National Commissioner during the Opening Ceremony of the Diamond Jubilee Jamboree held in Tiruchirappalli, Tamil Nadu, in January 2025.
- Unanimously approved in the National Executive Committee Meeting held on 24th May 2025 at Kurseong, Darjeeling.
- CNC Letter No 191/2025 dated 04/09/2025
- Clarified and approved in the Special National Executive Committee Meeting held in Hybrid Mode (Physical and Virtual) on 13 May 2026

All State Associations are hereby directed to Please note that this circular supersedes all earlier circulars issued on the subject.

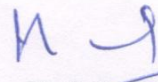

Date	:	24th to 30th December 2026 (IST Arrival : 23rd December Departure: 31st December)
Venue	:	The moot will be held at the National Cricket Ground, Purbachal-Sector No1, 300 Feet Road, Dhaka. The venue is easily accessible from Dhaka City (around 12 KM 30 minutes by road) and offers excellent facilities for camping adventure activities and cultural exchange.
Fee	:	USD 100.00 per participant which includes: Inland Transportation from designated point of entry in Dhaka City to the Moot Venue and back, Meals from dinner on 24 December to breakfast on 31 December, 2026, Accommodation (tent based), Programme materials, participant kit, event scarf, participation certificate, and Medical assistance during the moot
Eligibility	:	1. Rover Scouts (Youth Participants) Aged 18-25 years as of 24 December, 2026 2. Unit Leader: Adult Leaders (Aged 25 or above) accompanying Rovers. 3. International Service Team (IST): Adults aged 18 or above with proficiency in English & Camping experience. 4. Participants applying must be physically and mentally fit to engage in outdoor adventure activities. 1 Unit Leader is allowed to accompany upto 08 Rover Scouts. For Female participants a female Unit Leader is Mandatory to accompany them. He/she should be able to communicate in English and have valid passport. All Participants should complete Safe from Harm E-learning Certificate before attending the Forum.
