**SUB: CONSTITUTION OF THE NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS (NHQ) TRAINING TEAM OF SCOUT & GUIDE BY EMPANELLING RETIRED TRAINERS FROM INDIAN RAILWAYS, KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA SANGATHAN (KVS) AND NAVODAYA VIDYALAYA SAMITI (NVS)**

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Bharat Scouts and Guides has always been privileged to benefit from the dedicated services of thousands of committed Scout and Guide Trainers who have strengthened the Movement through their knowledge, experience and firm commitment to youth development.

It has, however, been observed that a number of experienced Trainers, particularly those retired from **Indian Railways, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) and Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti (NVS)**, are unable to continue contributing effectively to the Movement after their superannuation owing to administrative and membership-related constraints. Consequently, the Organisation is deprived of the invaluable expertise of these senior Trainers, while many of them are left without a suitable platform to continue serving the Movement to which they have devoted many years.

Recognising the importance of retaining experienced human resources and strengthening the quality of training across the Organisation, the Hon'ble Chief National Commissioner has been pleased to approve the constitution of an NHQ Training Team of Scout & Guide.

The primary objective of constituting the NHQ Training Team is to retain the experienced Trainers and create a pool of competent resource persons who may be called upon to support training, programme development, workshops, curriculum revision, special assignments and other organisational activities at the National Headquarters, National Training Centre, National Adventure Institute, Regional Offices and State Associations, as and when required.

Applications are invited from retired Scout and Guide Trainers who:

- have retired from **Indian Railways, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) or Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti (NVS)**;
- are **not presently registered with any State Association**;
- have not been debarred or subjected to disciplinary action by any State Association; and
- are willing to continue rendering voluntary service to The Bharat Scouts and Guides.

Eligible Trainers may register their membership directly with the National Headquarters and serve as voluntary members of the **NHQ Training Team, (NHQ Trainers)** subject to approval by the National Headquarters.

Eligible Trainers are requested to submit:

- the duly completed application in the prescribed format (enclosed);
- the prescribed **Individual Registration Fee (IRF) of ₹500/-** per annum, to be remitted to the official Bank Account of The Bharat Scouts and Guides; and
- proof of payment along with the application.

The completed application should reach the **National Headquarters on or before 10 August 2026.**

State Associations are requested to bring this circular to the notice of eligible retired Trainers.

In case any retired Trainer is under any disciplinary proceedings, has been debarred, or there exists any valid administrative objection regarding his/her registration, the concerned State Association shall communicate the details, with supporting reasons and records, to the National Headquarters on or before **05 August 2026.**

In the absence of any communication from the concerned State Association within the stipulated period, the National Headquarters shall proceed with the consideration of applications received on their own merit.

The decision of the National Headquarters regarding acceptance or otherwise of any application shall be final and binding.

All shortlisted applicants shall be required to attend the **NHQ Training Team Orientation and Capacity Building Workshop**, proposed to be held at the **National Training Centre, Pachmarhi/NHQ New Delhi** tentatively during the end of August or September, 2026.

The Workshop will focus on:

- Standardisation of training methodologies;
- Contemporary adult learning approaches;
- Digital learning tools and training technologies;
- Organisational policies and procedures;
- National training standards; and
- Assignment of responsibilities under the NHQ Training Team.

Participation in this Workshop shall be **mandatory** for empanelment in the NHQ Training Team. Trainers who do not attend and complete the Workshop shall **not be considered for empanelment**.

The Workshop shall be conducted on a **self-financing basis**. Detailed instructions, programme schedule and other logistical information will be communicated separately to the shortlisted applicants.

Upon successful completion of the Workshop and empanelment, members of the NHQ Training Team shall work under the overall guidance of the **Joint Director of Scouts (Programme & Training)** and the **Joint Director of Guides (Programme & Training)**. They may be assigned duties at the National Headquarters, National Training Centre, National Adventure Institute, Regional Offices or State Associations according to organisational requirements.

The Bharat Scouts and Guides firmly believes that the wisdom, experience and commitment of its senior Trainers constitute one of its greatest strengths. Through this initiative, the Organisation seeks to preserve this invaluable legacy while ensuring that future generations continue to benefit from their knowledge and guidance.

Your cooperation in giving this circular wide publicity among eligible retired Trainers is sincerely solicited.

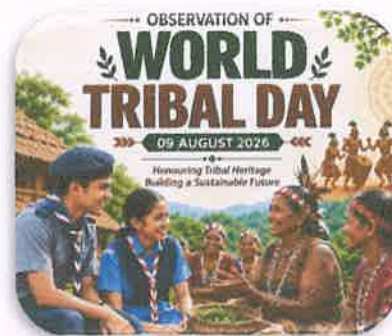
