WEATHER:	<p>During February Pachmarhi will be cold and the temperature of the area will be around 2 to 18 degrees. Hence sufficient warm clothes are to be brought accordingly.</p>
HOW TO REACH	<p>Pachmarhi is known as Queen of Satpura, one of the hill stations in Madhya Pradesh. The nearest Railway station is PIPARIYA, which is one-hour journey from Itrasi Junction towards Jabalpur (about 3 hour's journeys from Jabalpur towards Itarsi) in Itarsi-Allahabad Railway line. The distance from Pipariya to Pachmarhi is 56 km. The bust stand at Pipariya is just outside the Pipariya Railway Station. Transport buses are available. Numbers of private jeeps are also available on nominal rates from Pachmarhi bus stand to our Institute which is just 5 km away from bus stand. From Bhopal to Pachmarhi, 6 hours journey by road.</p>


