

The birth anniversary of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose will be **on January 23, 2026**, which will be his **129th birth anniversary**. The day is officially celebrated as **“Parakram Diwas”** by the Indian government to honor his contribution to the freedom struggle.

Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose was a great freedom fighter who fearlessly rebelled against the British and made significant contributions toward India's independence. His undeterred attitude, patriotic spirit, and firm resolve to see India free continue to inspire millions across the nation.

Netaji is also a somewhat controversial figure, however. He carried on relations with the Nazis and with the Imperial Japanese during **World War II**, although he seems to have done so to gain their support to build up an Indian National Army.

#### **1. Route March in Uniform (23 January 2026)**

Organize a disciplined route march by Scouts, Guides, Rovers, Rangers, and Unit Leaders in full uniform to honor Netaji's courage, patriotism, and leadership.

#### **2. Blood Donation Camp / Mass Sapling Plantation**

Conduct a voluntary blood donation drive or organize large-scale sapling plantation events promoting the spirit of service and environmental stewardship.

### 3. Quiz Competition on Netaji's Life

Hold quiz competitions based on the biography, achievements, and inspirational quotes of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose to enhance awareness among youth.

The **16th National Voters' Day 2026** will be observed on **25th January 2026** across the country. The primary objective of celebrating National Voters' Day is to encourage, facilitate, and maximise voter enrolment, especially among **youth and first-time voters**.

National Voters' Day has been celebrated since **2011** to commemorate the **foundation of the Election Commission of India on 25th January 1950**. The observance aims to encourage young citizens to participate actively in the electoral process and highlights the **Right to Vote as a fundamental democratic right**.

#### **Objectives of National Voters' Day**

##### **➤ Encouraging Voter Registration:**

To motivate newly eligible voters, especially youth, to enrol themselves and ensure no eligible voter is left out.

##### **➤ Creating Electoral Awareness:**

To educate voters about their rights, responsibilities, and the importance of voting in a democracy.

##### **➤ Promoting Informed and Ethical Voting:**

To emphasise informed decision-making and discourage malpractices such as vote-buying.

##### **➤ Strengthening Democratic Framework:**

To inculcate a culture of participation and strengthen inclusive and participatory democracy.

We request all the State Associations & Officer to initiate the **observation of National Voters' Day 2026** at the **State, District, and Unit Levels**, ensuring active participation of Scouts, Guides, Rovers, Rangers, and Unit Leaders.

#### **Suggested Activities for Observance of National Voters' Day 2026:**

##### **❖ Voters' Awareness Rally**

Organise rallies with placards and slogans highlighting the importance of voting. Promotes active citizenship and democratic participation.]

❖  **Poster Making & Slogan Writing**

Conduct creative competitions on themes related to voting and democracy. Encourages expression of ideas through art and words.

❖  **Mock Election Exercise**

Simulate the election process including voter list preparation and polling. Helps members understand the voting process practically.

❖  **Voter Registration Awareness Drive**

Guide eligible youth (18+) on voter registration through NVSP and Voter Helpline App. Creates awareness about enrolment and correction of voter details.

❖  **Debate / Elocution Programme**

Organise debates on youth participation and democratic values. Develops confidence, public speaking, and critical thinking skills.

❖  **Street Play (Nukkad Natak)**

Present short plays highlighting the power of one vote. Effectively spreads voter awareness among the general public.

❖  **Quiz on Democracy & Constitution**

Conduct quizzes on Indian Constitution, elections, and civic duties. Enhances knowledge of democratic institutions.


❖  **Social Media Awareness Campaign**
