Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters!

World Health Day is a global health awareness day observed every year on **07 April**.

The theme for World Health Day 2026 is **"Healthy Beginnings, Hopeful Futures."** This year's focus is on improving maternal and new-born health, emphasising the importance of quality care during pregnancy, childbirth, and the postnatal period. The theme highlights how early-life medical support can shape healthier communities and create better outcomes for future generations.

In 1948, the WHO held the **First World Health Assembly**. The Assembly decided to celebrate **07 April of each year**, with effect from 1950, as the **World Health Day**. The World Health Day is held to mark WHO's founding and is seen as an opportunity by the organization to draw worldwide attention to a subject of major importance to global health each year. The WHO organizes international, regional and local events on the Day related to a particular theme. World Health Day is acknowledged by various governments and non-governmental organizations with interests in public health issues, who also organize activities and highlight their support in media reports, such as the Global Health Council.

Key focus areas aligned with this year's theme include:

- ✓ Strengthening maternal and child health services
- ✓ Enhancing access to skilled birth attendants and essential care
- ✓ Promoting early screening and immunisation for new-borns
- ✓ Addressing maternal nutrition and postnatal care
- ✓ Raising awareness about preventable maternal and infant mortality

State Associations are requested to organize various activities / competitions at the State, District, Local Association, and Unit levels to mark the observance of World Health Day on 07 April 2026.

Suggested Activities for Observance of World Health Day 2026:


- **🌸 Maternal & Child Health Awareness Drives**
Organize awareness rallies and talks on maternal and newborn care in schools and communities. Invite local doctors/ANMs for interaction sessions.
- **🏥 Health Check-up Camps**
Conduct free health screening camps in collaboration with local hospitals/PHCs (BMI check, haemoglobin test, BP check, anaemia screening).

- 🍌 **Nutrition Awareness Programmes**
Organize poster-making, slogan writing, and exhibitions on balanced diet, iron-rich food, and maternal nutrition.
- 👩 **Mother & Child Care Workshops**
Sessions on newborn care, breastfeeding awareness, vaccination importance, and early childhood development.
- 🧘 **Yoga & Wellness Sessions**
Mass yoga demonstrations, prenatal yoga awareness (with expert guidance), and meditation sessions for physical and mental well-being.
- 🎭 **Street Plays & Role Plays**
Scouts and Guides can perform skits highlighting maternal health, hygiene, and preventive healthcare.
- 🎨 **Poster/Painting Competitions**
Encouraging Scouts and Guides to creatively express the theme through artwork that highlights awareness, social responsibility, and positive messaging.
- 📱 **Social media campaigns**
using hashtags like: **#WorldHealthDay2026 #HealthyBeginnings #BSGINDIA**
- 🌱 **Community Outreach Service**
 - Distribution of sanitary kits
 - Hygiene awareness drives
 - Plantation drives linked with healthy living





06. Literacy and digital awareness Programme


All State Associations are requested to identify **one or more School or Village in each District** for adoption and implement need-based community development activities with the active participation of Cubs, Bulbuls, Scouts, Guides, Rovers, Rangers, Adult Leaders, and volunteers. Proper coordination with local authorities, school management, and community leaders should be ensured for effective planning and implementation. The activities undertaken under the Diamond Jubilee initiative will be appropriately documented, and selected reports and photographs will be showcased in the **special Diamond Jubilee Coffee Table Book publish by the National Headquarters.**

Adequate planning, safety measures, and systematic documentation (photographs, short reports, and impact details) must be maintained. A consolidated report of the activities undertaken, along with photographs and brief outcomes, should be submitted to the National Headquarters upon completion of the programme on 75years@bsgindia.org and pro@bsgindia.org by **15th June 2026**. On receipt of reports, first 50 Groups will get appreciation certificate and participants will get a participation Certificate.

This Diamond Jubilee initiative is expected to create long-term community impact while reinforcing the values and mission of the Bharat Scouts and Guides. All concerned are requested to take necessary action to ensure the successful implementation of this meaningful community-based activity.
