BASE CAMP: MAIS, Training Centre, Bulbule Gangtok, Sikkim.

How to Reach Training Centre, Bulbule, Gangtok Campsite from NJP/Siliguri :

The Mountaineering & Adventure Institute of Sikkim (MAIS), is located at Bulbule, Gangtok, East Sikkim and can be reached conveniently by road from New Jalpaiguri (NJP) or Siliguri.

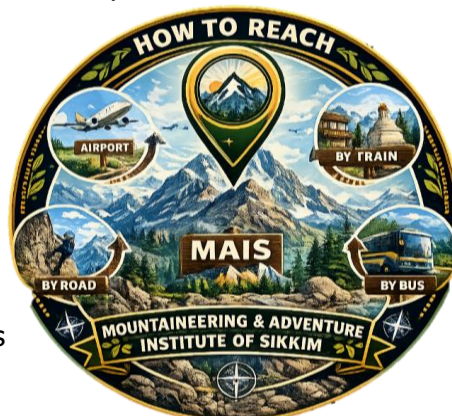
🚂 By Train

The nearest railway station is New Jalpaiguri (NJP) Railway Station, which is well connected to major cities across India.

🚗 From NJP/Siliguri to Bulbule, Gangtok

Participants may travel from NJP Railway Station or Siliguri to Bulbule, Gangtok by shared taxi, reserved taxi, or bus.

One can take shared Taxi or Bus from NJP/Siliguri to Gangtok which is Approximately 114 km. From Gangtok to Bulbule shared Taxi's are also available. From Gangtok Taxi/Bus Stand Bulbule is approximately 03-05 KM.



NB: If a group consist of 30-40 participants, Bus facility can be provided at NJP Railway Station on nominal payment basis subject to advance information prior to 15 days of arrival at NJP Railway Station and on confirmation only.

Participants are advised to plan their journey in advance and make suitable onward travel arrangements to ensure timely arrival at the campsite. Shared and reserved taxi services are readily available from NJP Railway Station, Siliguri to Gangtok.

For the booking of seats: Scout Guide Welfare Fund **₹1,500/-** per head is to be paid in advance which is non – refundable but can be adjusted in other programmes within the same financial year. The Booking confirmation will be informed after receiving of registration fee. For direct deposit through Bank, the Bank charges will be borne by the candidate / Institution. To motivate cashless transactions, participants can do online Transactions/IMPS/ RTGS/NEFT/ Others using following details: -

Booking will be made on "**First Come First Serve Basis**". Hence proceed registration without waiting and grab the opportunity. Preference may be given to under 45 years of age.

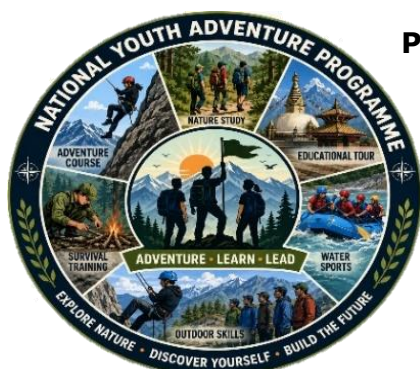
Selection Letter will be sent on receipt of Scout Guide Welfare Fund as registration fee **1,500/-** per head. The balance amount of **₹3500/- per head** must be remitted via online bank transfer at least fifteen days before the Camp.

₹5,000/- Per head to be remitted toward **Scout Guide Welfare Fund (This will cover Accommodation, Food, Adventure Course, Nature Study Trekking & Educational Tour, Survival Training, Out Door Skills, Souvenir Items and Activities.**

The original Application, Medical & Risk MAIS Institutional certificate should be produced at the time of Registration, without these mandatory document's participants will not be admitted. **Each Participant will be awarded National Level Participation Certificate on successful completion of the programme.**

Note: No one is permitted without Registration, Risk, Medical Certificate & MAIS registration from. The escort teacher if any should be physically & medically fit. Participants will proceed only on receipt of selection letter from NHQ.

Eligibility (Who can participate) : The programme is open to members of The Bharat Scouts and Guides, educational institutions, adventure clubs, well-wishers of the organizations, and other youth organizations interested in adventure & educational activities. Participants should be in the age group of 15 to 45 years and must be Physically and medically fit and can bear the strain of adventure and related activities. Individuals may also participate independently with valid Government identity proof.



Programmes: Adventure Activities – Adventure Course, Nature Study, Educational Tour, Survival Training, Trekking, Out Door Skills, Camp Fire and Local Sightseeing.

What to Bring: The participants will bring following materials along with them.

- ❖ **UPPER BODY CLOTHING:** Full Sleeve T-Shirts (Quick Dry), Jacket, Raincoat/Poncho all items to be carried as per need of the individual **but Mandatory**.
- ❖ **LOWER BODY CLOTHING:** Innerwear (undergarments), Trekking Pants (Quick Dry), Track Pant for Night Stay, all items to be carried as per need of the individual **but Mandatory**.
- ❖ **FOOTWEAR:** Good quality Trekking Shoes with Grip and waterproofed 02-03 pairs of Cotton socks, slippers.
- ❖ **HEAD & HAND PROTECTION:** P-Cap – 01pair and pair Sunglasses
- ❖ **PERSONAL ESSENTIALS:** Backpack with capacity of (50 to 60 Liters), Day Pack (20 to 30 Liters) with rain cover, water bottle, Trekking Pole, Personal Toiletries, Quick Dry Towel, note book, Pen, First Aid Kit or personal medicines if any, Plate, Glass, Spoon etc.



NB: The above items are **Mandatory**. If any participant fails to carry the recommended materials individually, the Bharat Scouts and Guides is not responsible.

Risk Management - The Bharat Scouts and Guides take every care of the participants sincerely, but **The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Youth Adventure Institute** will not be responsible for any accident, illness or injury during the programme. The escorting teachers/individual should take extra precaution/care of their students/themselves before, during and after the camp.

Accommodation - Accommodation will be provided in Room on sharing basis with basic facilities.

Weather - Winter temperatures range between 6°C and 10°C, while summer temperatures generally range from 16°C to 20°C; participants are advised to carry clothing accordingly, including sufficient warm clothing's.

वर्ष 2026–2027 के दौरान सिक्किम पर्वतारोहण एवं साहसिक संस्थान (एमएआईएस) में आयोजित किए जाने वाले राष्ट्रीय युवा साहसिक कार्यक्रम से संबंधित जानकारी निम्नानुसार है:

आगमन: कार्यक्रम के प्रथम दिवस पूर्वाह्न **प्रस्थान:** कार्यक्रम के अंतिम दिवस दोपहर के भोजन के उपरांत।

बेस कैंप : एमएआईएस प्रशिक्षण केंद्र, बुलबुले, गंगटोक, सिक्किम।

एनजेपी (न्यू जलपाईगुड़ी) / सिलीगुड़ी से प्रशिक्षण केंद्र, बुलबुले, गंगटोक कैंप स्थल तक पहुँचने का मार्ग

सिक्किम पर्वतारोहण एवं साहसिक संस्थान (एमआईएस) पूर्वी सिक्किम के गंगटोक स्थित बुलबुले क्षेत्र में अवस्थित है। संस्थान तक न्यू जलपाईगुड़ी रेलवे स्टेशन अथवा सिलीगुड़ी से सड़क मार्ग द्वारा सुविधापूर्वक पहुँचा जा सकता है।

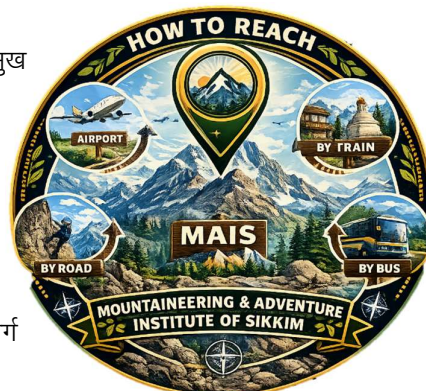
🚆 रेल मार्ग द्वारा

निकटतम रेलवे स्टेशन न्यू जलपाईगुड़ी रेलवे स्टेशन है, जो भारत के प्रमुख शहरों से रेल मार्ग द्वारा अच्छी तरह जुड़ा हुआ है।

🚗 एनजेपी /सिलीगुड़ी से बुलबुले, गंगटोक तक

प्रतिभागी न्यू जलपाईगुड़ी रेलवे स्टेशन अथवा सिलीगुड़ी से बुलबुले, गंगटोक तक साझा टैक्सी, आरक्षित टैक्सी या बस द्वारा यात्रा कर सकते हैं।

एनजेपी/सिलीगुड़ी से गंगटोक की दूरी लगभग 114 किलोमीटर है। इस मार्ग पर नियमित रूप से साझा टैक्सी एवं बस सेवाएँ उपलब्ध हैं।



गंगटोक पहुँचने के बाद प्रतिभागी बुलबुले के लिए साझा टैक्सी का उपयोग कर सकते हैं। गंगटोक टैक्सी/बस स्टैंड से बुलबुले की दूरी लगभग 3 से 5 किलोमीटर है, जिसे स्थानीय परिवहन के माध्यम से आसानी से तय किया जा सकता है।

नोट : यदि किसी दल में 30 से 40 प्रतिभागी हों, तो न्यू जलपाईगुड़ी रेलवे स्टेशन से बस सुविधा कम शुल्क पर उपलब्ध कराई जा सकती है। इसके लिए एनजेपी रेलवे स्टेशन पर आगमन की तिथि से कम-से-कम 15 दिन पूर्व अग्रिम सूचना देना आवश्यक होगा तथा यह सुविधा केवल पूर्व पुष्टि के आधार पर उपलब्ध होगी।

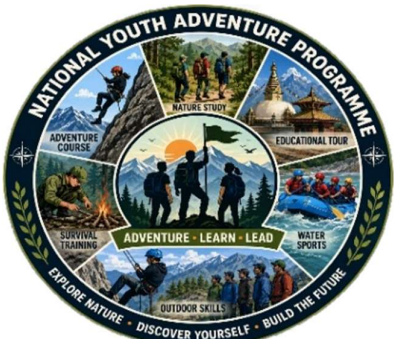

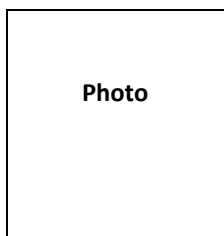

Self-Development Activities

The programme will include a variety of self-development activities such as **Kim's Game, Backwoodsman Cooking, Quiz Competitions,** and sessions on the **basic knowledge of The Bharat Scouts and Guides Organization.** These activities are designed for understanding of the Scout Movement.

Risk Management - The Bharat Scouts and Guides take every care of the participants sincerely, but **The Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Adventure Institute, Kurseong, Darjeeling** will not be responsible for any accident, illness or injury during the programme. The escorting teachers should take extra precaution/care of their students before, during and after the camp.

Accommodation - Accommodation will be provided in permanent shelters.

Weather - Winter temperatures range between 2.5°C and 11.2°C, while summer temperatures will be pleasant; participants are advised to carry clothing accordingly.



How to reach – National Adventure Institute, Kurseong, Darjeeling

Reaching the campsite is convenient and well-connected through air, rail, and road networks. Participants are advised to plan their travel in advance and make necessary arrangements for a smooth and timely arrival.

Bagdogra International Airport – The nearest airport, well connected with major cities across India, offering convenient air travel options.

New Jalpaiguri (NJP) Railway Station & Siliguri Junction Railway Station

Both stations serve as major rail gateways for reaching Kurseong, Darjeeling. The campsite is located approximately 15–20 minutes walking distance from Kurseong Railway Station.



Road Transport: Tata Sumo and Jeep services are easily available from NJP/Siliguri to Kurseong. Approximate fare: ₹3,000 per jeep for up to 08 members.
