-  **Slogan Writing** – Write creative slogans promoting Hindi.

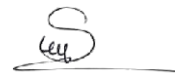
- 📖 **Storytelling** – Narrate inspiring stories in Hindi.

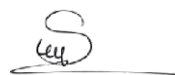

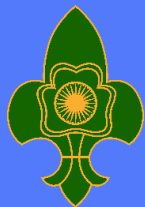
