This day is also commemorated worldwide as the ***International Day of Non-Violence*** by the United Nations, in recognition of Gandhiji's philosophy of **Ahinsa (non-violence)**, through which he proved that peaceful means can achieve even the greatest of victories.

Dress and act like Mahatma Gandhi, take a selfie/video, and share it on social media.

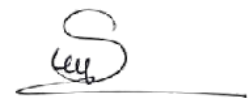
9 🧵 Khadi & Charkha for Atmanirbhar Bharat

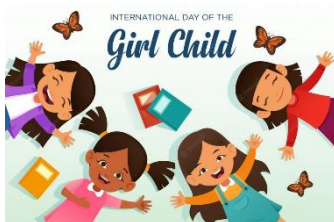

SUB: CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL DAY OF GIRL CHILD On 11th October 2025

Dear Sir/Madam,

Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters!

International Day of the Girl Child is celebrated every year on **11th October** to promote girls' empowerment and highlight the challenges they face across the globe. It is a day to recognize that girls need not wait until adulthood to create change – they are already making an impact today.

Each year Girl Guides and Girl Scouts celebrate IDG and use it as an opportunity to learn how to be advocates and make the world a better place by speaking out on the issue they care about and taking action in their communities.

The International Day of the Girl Child for 2025 theme is **"The girl I am, the change I lead: Girls on the frontlines of crisis"**. This theme emphasizes girls' leadership and agency, particularly in times of crisis, and was developed in collaboration with girls and their organizations to reflect their experiences and priorities.

This year's theme calls for recognition of girls' leadership in the face of multiple crises.

All over the world, girls are stepping up to meet today's biggest challenges. They're organizing in their communities, fighting for climate justice and demanding an end to violence. Girls are asking to be seen not only for the challenges they face, but for who they are and the solutions they bring. Yet, too often their voices go unheard, their actions ignored, their needs and rights pushed aside.

Did you know? (As per United Nations Data 2025)

- 🧑🏫 Girls aged 15–19 is **twice as likely as boys** to be out of education, employment or training. In fragile contexts, they are nearly **90% more likely** to be out of school compared to girls in stable settings.
- 💔 Nearly **1 in 4 girls** aged 15–19 who have ever been in a relationship have experienced **intimate partner violence**.
- 👶 About **1 in 5 young women** aged 20–24 was married as children. Alarming, **9 out of 10 countries** with the highest child-marriage prevalence are experiencing **humanitarian crises**.
- ⚠️ Crisis, conflict, and displacement significantly increase the risk of **child marriage, sexual violence, and maternal mortality** among girls.

- 🧑 Over the past 20 years, **self-harm** has remained one of the **leading causes of death** among adolescent girls.

All State Associations are kindly requested to motivate and inspire members to actively participate in these activities and submit their consolidated reports in time.

Suggested Activities for International Day of the Girl 2025

Girl-Led Dialogue

Organize a panel discussion, debate, or talk circle where girls share their views on leadership during crises such as climate change, conflict, or gender-based violence.

Awareness Campaign

Launch a campaign (posters, street plays, social media) amplifying girls' voices and highlighting the theme "*The girl I am, the change I lead.*"

Action for Change

Encourage girl members to lead a local initiative such as a cleanliness drive, tree planting, or community service project, showcasing their leadership in action.

Creative Expression

Host poster-making, essay writing, poetry, or short-video competitions on the theme of girl leadership and empowerment.

Mentorship Circles

Connect young girls with women leaders, or senior Trainers for interactive sessions on resilience, leadership, and advocacy.

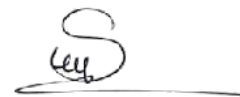

**SUB: CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL UNITY DAY OR RASHTRIYA EKTA DIWAS
ON 31ST OCTOBER 2025.**

Greetings from the Bharat Scouts and Guides, National Headquarters!

The *National Unity Day* or *Rashtriya Ekta Diwas* is celebrated every year on 31st October to commemorate the birth anniversary of India's first Home Minister, **Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel**. This year marks the **150th birth anniversary** of Sardar Patel, fondly remembered as the *Iron Man of India*.

The *Rashtriya Ekta Diwas* provides an opportunity to reaffirm the inherent strength and resilience of our nation towards upholding the unity, integrity, and security of our country. In honors of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the government of India constructed the world's tallest statue of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel near the Narmada River in Gujarat which symbolizes the strength of unity in India. The main objective of the celebration is to uplift the nation's unity and spread awareness about Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's contribution to Indian history.

He played an important role in the integration of many Indian princely states to make an Indian federation. At the time of independence, he played the key role in convincing several princely states to align with the Indian Union. He also worked hard as a social leader for the independence of India. He is recognized as the real unifier of India for his colossal contribution to integrating and making India a united (Ek Bharat) and an independent nation. He requested the people of India to live together by uniting in order to create "Shresth Bharat" (Foremost India). He is also remembered as the "Patron saint of India's civil servants" as he established the modern all-India services system.

The **Rashtriya Ekta Diwas** or **National Unity Day** was introduced by the Indian government in the year 2014 to pay tribute to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on his birth anniversary for his extraordinary work in keeping India united. The first *Rashtriya Ekta Diwas* event was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi who flagged off a program **"Run for Unity"** in New Delhi in 2014.

Like the previous year, this year also The Bharat Scouts and Guides will join hands to be a part of Rashtriya Ekta Diwas in commemorating National Unity Day on 31st October, 2025.

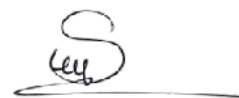
