Every year, on **1st December**, the world commemorates **World AIDS Day**, providing a platform to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS and honour the lives affected by the epidemic. This year marks the **37th commemoration** of this significant day. Over the past few decades, remarkable progress has been made in addressing HIV/AIDS.

The theme for **World AIDS Day 2025** is: **“Collective Action: Sustain and Accelerate HIV Progress.”**

This observance reminds us of our continued efforts to eliminate HIV-related stigma and encourages collective responsibility.

The Bharat Scouts and Guides, being the largest uniformed youth educational movement, appeals to all **State Headquarters** to join hands in observing **World AIDS Day** and create awareness within the community about HIV/AIDS.

#### **Some suggested activities are given hereunder.**

- ❖ **Conduct Awareness Programmes/Rallies while wearing a Red Ribbon**  
Mobilize Scouts/Guides and community members to participate in awareness rallies. Highlight the importance of HIV/AIDS prevention and stigma reduction.
- ❖ **Organize Blood Donation Camps**  
Encourage eligible volunteers to donate blood safely through certified medical teams. Promote the message of saving lives through voluntary blood donation.
- ❖ **Organize Medical Camps**  
Arrange basic health check-ups with healthcare professionals for community members. Provide counselling and information related to HIV prevention and care.
- ❖ **Organize First Aid Camps**  
Offer hands-on first aid training to youth and community groups. Enhance preparedness and response in emergency situations.

❖  **Slogan Writing/Essay Writing Competitions**

Engage participants to express awareness messages creatively. Encourage youth to reflect and learn about HIV/AIDS.


❖  **Poster Making/Drawing/Painting Competitions on the Theme**

#### **Some suggested activities are given hereunder.**

- **Spend time with soldiers' families**  
Visit families of serving/retired personnel to express gratitude. Spend time listening to their stories and share memorable moments online.
- **Flag Hoisting Ceremony**  
Organize a ceremonial hoisting of the National Flag in schools/units. Include a talk about Armed Forces Flag Day and honour the sacrifices of soldiers.

➤  **Painting and Drawing Competition**

Invite participants to create artwork on themes of patriotism, soldiers, or national pride. Display selected work at schools/communities to foster respect for armed forces.

➤  **Patriotic Singing Programme**

Encourage group songs or solo performances expressing national devotion. Can be organized at public spaces, schools, or community halls.

➤  **Cultural Dance Performance**

Present folk or traditional dances reflecting India's patriotic heritage. Promote unity and cultural pride through artistic expression.

➤  **Patriotic Costume Contest**

Participants dress as freedom fighters, soldiers, or national heroes. Share brief background stories of characters chosen to enhance learning.

➤  **Quiz Contest**

Conduct quizzes focusing on armed forces, national history, wars, and heroes. Promote learning and awareness among youth about defence services.

➤  **Flag Relay Race**

Organize a team relay where participants carry the National Flag. Reinforce teamwork, fitness, and patriotic enthusiasm.

➤  **Historic Walk in Your City**

Plan a visit to war memorials, statues, or historic sites. Promote learning about national heritage and martyr sacrifices.

**Human Rights Day** is observed every year on **10 December**. It commemorates the day in 1948. The United Nations General Assembly adopted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Human Rights Day promotes equality, peace, justice, and the protection of human rights. Human Rights are the basic rights we have been given to ensure our safety and protection. They are universal, which means they apply to everyone without exception, regardless of race, sex, gender, age or nationality.

Human Rights Day makes it easy for people to remember the importance of human rights. It's a day that recognizes the struggles and sacrifices of those who fought for the rights that we all enjoy now.

The theme for Human Rights Day on December 10, 2025, is "**Our Everyday Essentials**". This theme emphasizes that human rights are essential to our daily lives, often taken for granted, and form the foundation of our **freedom, dignity, and security**. It highlights the positive, achievable nature of human rights and their connection to everyday life.

The **National Human Rights Commission - NHRC**, India has continually worked to ensure the protection of civil, political, economic, social and cultural rights. Through its numerous programs and activities, the Commission has also made significant contributions to mainstreaming a human rights-centred approach in government policies and programs, as well as increasing human rights knowledge and sensitization among public officials and civil society.

The Bharat Scouts and Guides, being the largest uniformed educational movement, appeals to all **Adult Leaders** to observe **Human Rights Day** and engage all **Cubs, Bulbuls, Scouts, Guides, Rovers, and Rangers** to inspire them on this significant occasion.

#### **Some, suggested activities are given hereunder: -**

##### ➤ **Awareness Campaigns**

Organize campaigns highlighting the importance of human rights within the community. Focus on issues affecting vulnerable groups to foster inclusivity.

##### ➤ **Workshops/Interactive Sessions**

Host sessions to educate members about human rights and how to protect them. Promote advocacy skills and practical understanding of rights.

##### ➤ **Self-Advocacy Workshops**

Empower youth and community members to understand and defend their rights.

➤  **Panel Talks / Discussions**

Invite experts to share insights on safeguarding rights and preventing discrimination. Engage participants in open dialogue on equality and justice.

➤  **Mock Human Rights Court**

Conduct mock sessions to help participants understand justice procedures. Build awareness about legal protections and responsibilities.

➤  **Street Play / Nukkad Natak**

Present short plays demonstrating real-life human rights challenges. Encourage empathy and community awareness through storytelling.

➤  **Poster / Slogan / Essay Competitions**

Encourage creative expression on human rights themes. Display selected work to promote awareness.

➤  **Human Rights Quiz**

Organize quizzes covering human rights topics, UDHR, and NHRC. Motivate youth to expand their knowledge.

➤  **Social Media Campaign – #EmpoweringVoices**

Share stories, messages, and resources promoting equality and dignity. Encourage members to spread awareness online.

Let us come together to honour Human Rights Day and reaffirm our dedication to equality, justice, and dignity for all. Together, we can make a difference.
