
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# GENERAL INFORMATION

# MEET THE BHARAT SCOUTS AND GUIDES

## A BRIEF HISTORY

The Bharat Scouts and Guides (BSG) a SAGNO is one of India's largest and most esteemed youth organisations established with the aim of fostering character development, leadership, and community service among young people.

Scouting in India began in 1909 under British rule, inspired by the global movement founded by Lord Baden-Powell. Guiding followed in 1911. Several independent Scout and Guide organisations emerged in different regions of India during this period.

After India gained independence in 1947, efforts were made to unify these organisations. In 1950, the Boy Scouts Association of India and the Hindustan Scouts Association merged to form the Bharat Scouts and Guides. A year later, in 1951, the Girl Guides Association also joined, creating a single, unified organisation for both boys and girls.

BSG is recognised by the World Organisation of the Scout Movement (WOSM) and the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS). It has played a vital role in promoting Scouting and Guiding principles across India, with a focus on character building, skill development, and community service.



## Membership

The Bharat Scouts and Guides has a total membership of 6.2 million individuals, comprising 3.8 million Scout Wing and 2.4 million Guide Wing.



# USEFUL INFORMATION BEFORE YOU BOOK

## VISA INFORMATION

**You will need to apply for a Conference Visa to attend the conference. Please follow these steps to ensure a smooth application process:**

### **Contact Your Nearest Indian Mission:**

Begin by inquiring about the Conference Visa application process at the Indian Embassy or Consulate closest to your location. They will provide specific details and requirements. You can also visit the official website of the Indian Visa Online Application Center (<https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/>) and see if you are eligible for the online visa. If yes, follow the instructions and apply for the visa.

Depending on your location, you may need to schedule an appointment at the nearest Indian embassy or consulate to submit your application and biometric data (such as fingerprints and photograph).

### **Receive Your Invitation Letter:**

You will receive an official invitation from The Director, Bharat Scouts and Guides (conference organisers) in India. This letter is a key document required for your visa application.

### **Ministry Clearance (If Required):**

In some cases, the Government of India may require security clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) or the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) for specific participants or for visits to restricted areas. If clearance is required, please inform the conference hosts immediately. The hosts will handle the clearance process, but it will take additional time. To facilitate the clearance process, all necessary participant information must be submitted promptly upon request.

### **Registration and Clearance Timeline:**

If your clearance is required, the process will begin after registration closes in April. Please note that clearance timelines may vary, and your patience during this period is appreciated.

### **Application Submission:**

Once you have the required documents, including your invitation letter and any additional clearances, submit your visa application to the Indian Visa office. It is recommended to apply at least 30 days before your travel date to avoid delays.

For any questions or assistance during this process, feel free to reach out to The Director, Bharat Scouts and Guides (conference organisers). If you require a visa support letter, please let us know during the registration process or email us at [fapw@waggggs.org](mailto:fapw@waggggs.org).

Make sure you carry all your travel documents including the passport, tickets, and letter from Bharat Scouts and Guides. You will need those to apply for the on-arrival visa. Do not forget to buy travel insurance and carry its certificate with you for any unforeseen circumstances. We look forward to welcoming you to the event in India!

## INSURANCE

Neither the Bharat Scouts and Guides nor WAGGS can take responsibility for any medical, accident, or personal property claims by participants of the Regional Gathering (other than those that may fall under public liability). WAGGS will also not be liable for travel costs in the event of cancellation of the Gathering for any reason.

All participants must arrange their own insurance for travel, health, accident, and personal property. When purchasing your travel insurance, please ensure that COVID-19 coverage is included. Please also note that self-medication is the responsibility of the participant.

In the case of accidents or severe illness, participants will be taken to a hospital situated nearby. Please note that delegates who make use of this facility will be charged for medical consultations, treatment, and medication, and should ensure they have appropriate personal insurance.

## AIRPORT TRANSFERS


